



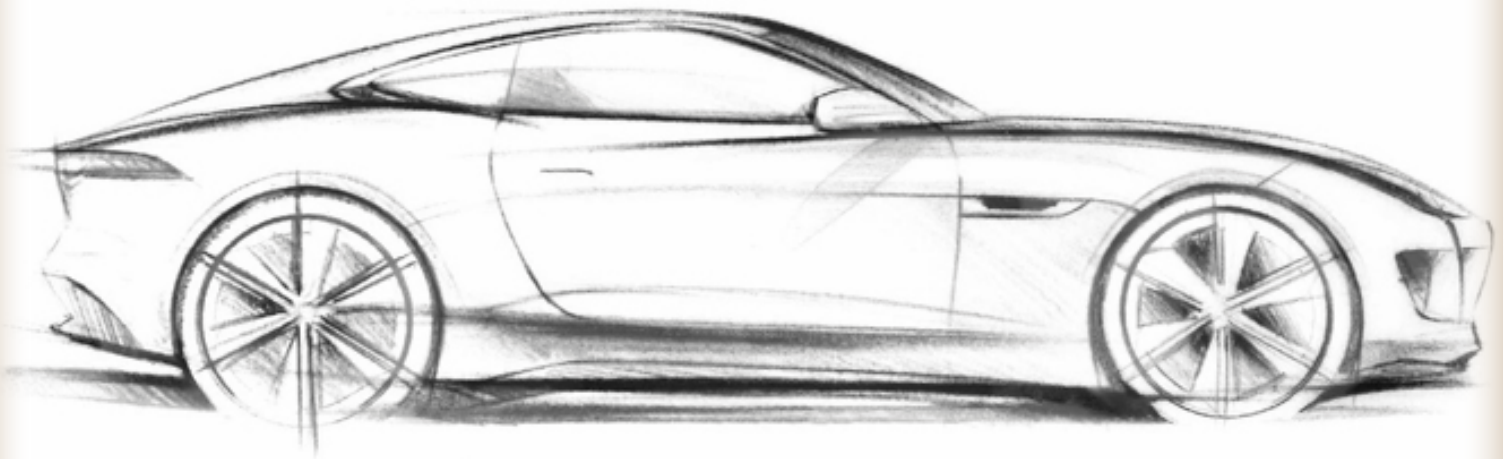

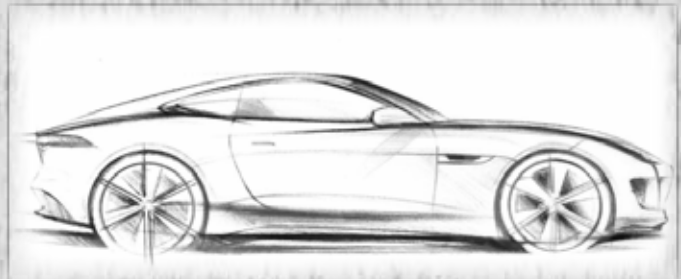

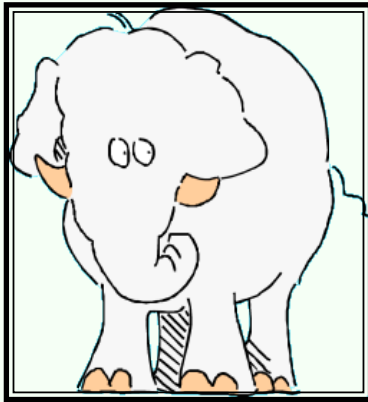

I purchased the car from my father in 2005, who had been the owner since 1984. It is unrestored with 50,500 original miles. I have receipts back to, I believe, 39,000 miles in the early 80s. Until recently it has been an under appreciated vehicle because it is a fixed head coupe as well as an automatic, both of which purists and collectors seem to shy away from. Many years ago there was a bit of ridicule around some Jaguar circles because of the peculiar orange-red color. Research revealed it to be a somewhat rare color reportedly only shipped to America and only on the MC (limited edition) models. The paint, to my knowledge, is completely original except for the boot which was re-sprayed in the late 80s due to a minor fender bender.

- Vehicle was built on February 21, 1956 and registered with Jaguar Diamler Heritage Trust (JDHT)
- Only 396 FHC automatics produced, the initial one manufactured on Jan 10, 1956 (only 6 weeks prior to this vehicle)
- Equipped with original MC components; larger C-type heads, duel exhaust, windshield washers, and wire wheels.

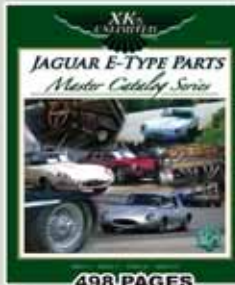

BACK TRACKS

Jaguars leap in value at RM Auctions

Once upon a time, a friend defined for me loyalty in Jaguar terms. "It's when you buy a Jaguar and never sell it, at any price," he said. That's how each member of the San Diego Jaguar Club sees it, too, I'm sure. Still, one always wonders just what their favorite car might be worth.

To get a good sense of that value, consider keeping track of high-end car auctions around the country – especially with a group like RM Auctions. As Back Tracks went to press in August, RM Auctions was due to hold its annual event in Monterey, and it had a host of gorgeous Jags on offer.



Perhaps the most impressive was a 1938 Jaguar SS100 3.5 Liter Roadster, one of just 118 original 3.5 liter examples. This particular car is documented in the SS100 Register, and includes a certificate of origin from the Coventry-based Jaguar Heritage. According to RM, this car has had a recent concours-level restoration and is a former CCA and AACA award winner.

Price? Well, RM gave its estimate at between \$700,000 and \$800,000 – a song considering the car's history.

Quoting the Classic Jaguar Association SS100 Register, RM said the car on offer was delivered new to Lt.-Col. A.W. Tate in England, and it is believed he entered it into a number of amateur-level races.

The car's known history picks up again in 1964, when it was imported into the USA by early Jaguar enthusiast Ken Gardner, who commissioned what RM says was a "comprehensive, concours-level restoration."

After the work was finished, the SS100 went on to score 99.25 points and win the Primary Foreign Class at the July 1970 Indianapolis Grand Classic. That December, Gardner sold the SS100 to Floyd Moore of Glenview, Illinois, who went on to win an AACA National First Prize.

In 1984 Moore sold the car to Bernard Nevoral who added it to his collection of classic sporting cars. Nevoral kept the car for 25 years, entering it into a number of vintage rallies, and keeping it maintained by knowledgeable specialists. Coming right up to the present, in 2010-11 this SS100 had a professional body-off-frame restoration performed by Jeff's Resurrections of Taylor, Texas. The process included a rebuild of the original, matching-numbers 3.5-liter engine.

As finished in factory-correct blue with rich red leather hides, the car also features gleaming brightwork and such desirable period features as wire-mesh headlamp guards, aero screens, classic-type Dunlop racing tires and a number of motor club badges.

What makes this car a *pièce de résistance*, though, is the fact that it is accompanied by a remarkable set of documentation: all restoration records, copies of prior title documents, older handwritten service records, a Jaguar Heritage certificate, copies of the SS100 Register and Classic Jaguar Association newsletters, as well as newspaper clippings and SS100-related literature.

What did this car achieve in the auction? We'll have the results of the bidding in the next issue for this splendid SS100 along with the other 11 classic Jaguars that joined it on the block at Monterey.
