

# 2012 SDJC Officers Call for Nominations



The SDJC is now accepting nominations for the seven elected officer positions for 2012. Those positions are: President, 1st Vice President-Activities, 2nd Vice President-Membership, Director, Treasurer, Secretary and Newsletter Editor.

Serving on the Board requires some work, but can be very rewarding. You will help in setting the path forward, creating a Club that will contribute to the pleasure of owning and driving the Jaguars of the future. In addition, it's a chance to get to know more members and become intimately involved with Club activities.

The elected officers are listed below along with a brief description of duties. In addition, nominees for Membership, Treasurer, Secretary and Newsletter Editor should be familiar with the software used for those functions.

• The President is responsible for the overall coordination of the Club's operation, and is required to preside over the monthly Board meetings. In addition, the President writes a monthly column for the Jaguar Tracks.

• The 1st Vice President-Activities is in charge of coordinating the Club's events including tours, rallies, the Annual Concours, etc.

• The 2nd Vice President-Membership manages the Club's membership records which are kept in Excel, and MS Word reports to the Board monthly on changes in the Club's membership count, communicates with new and prospective members and coordinates with the national club, JCNA.

• The Directors are responsible to the membership and will report to them regularly.

• The Treasurer is responsible for the accounting and administration of the Club's funds, including payment of bills and production of a monthly financial statement. The Club's finances are kept in Quickbooks, (non-profit company edition), so familiarity with that software is a big plus. The treasurer reports monthly at the regular Board Meetings.

• The Secretary documents the Club's administration through the production of minutes of each Board meeting, preparation of the meeting agenda and attendance at the meetings. These records are kept in Word format.

• The Newsletter Editor is responsible for publishing the Jaguar Tracks each month. This is accomplished using; Adobe InDesign 5.5, and MS Word.

In addition to the elected officers, the Board includes fourteen other members appointed by the President. These positions may be on page 27 of this newsletter. If you are interested in serving in any of these positions please contact me.

All nominees should be prepared to attend a monthly Board of Directors meeting which is generally held on the Wednesday; following the second Friday of each month at a central location. The meeting begins promptly at 6:30PM and normally concludes by 8:00PM.



### Jaguars leap in value at RM Auctions

Jaguars did well at RM Auctions in Monterey last month, with ten cars sold for a total of \$1,861,750

or an average of \$186,175 per car. Perhaps the most impressive was a 1938 Jaguar SS100 3.5 Liter Roadster, one of just



118 original 3.5 liter examples, which was estimated at between \$700,000 and \$800,000. Its actual going price was just below the lower estimate at \$687,500.

A 1990 Jaguar XJ220 came in at number two on the list, attracting a bid of \$231,000. RM described the car as finished in the original classic silver with a grey leather interior and a remarkable 2,900 original kilometers on



its odometer. The car was built in August 1993, and it is one of the group of 37 unsold XJ220s that were carefully stored,

sparingly driven, and serviced at the Jaguar factory in Coventry.

Third down the list in terms of the bidding was a 1960 Jaguar XK150 3.8 Drophead Coupe, which reached \$225,500 – perfectly within the range RM had estimated at \$210,000-\$250,000. This is a fairly rare car, too, as only about 2,680 were built through the end

of production in mid-1961. Of these, about 586 were 220bhp, 3.8-liter cars, including S 8 3 8 6 6 8 D N, the car sold at Monterey.



A 1963 E-Type 3.8 Series I Roadster came in fourth among Jaguars at the auction, attracting a bid of \$132,000 against the earlier bid range of \$125,000-\$150,000. RM's description of this car will absolutely please at least one or two members of SDJC. "Having undergone a complete, no-expense-spared restoration by

Jaguar spec i a l i s t s C l a s s i c Showcase of Oceanside, California, it displays a very high degree of craftsmanship."



Lot 110, the fifth highest on our list, was a 1966 Jaguar E-Type Series I 4.2-Liter Fixed Head Coupe. The initial estimate of this car came in at \$115,000-\$140,000. The winning bid came in at \$123,750 – and not surprisingly, either. Another sample of the handiwork accomplished by Oceanside's Classic Showcase, this Jag was described as "ideal for a discriminating Jaguar collector's collection."

Rounding off the top ten were: a 1948 Jaguar 3.5-Liter Mark IV Drophead Coupe which went for \$110,000 against an estimated \$90,000-\$120,000; a 1953 Jaguar



XK120 Fixed Head Coupe, which also went for \$110,000 – just under its estimate of \$120,000-\$140,000;

and a 1956 Jaguar XK140 MC Roadster, which was estimated at \$70,000-\$90,000 and went for \$82,500. Tenth on the list was 1969 Jaguar E-Type Series II 4.2-Liter Fixed Head Coupe, which sold for \$55,000 or just below its estimated value of \$60,000-\$80,000.

All in all, a splendid time was guaranteed for all.
