



#### Daul Novak's rare 1990 V12 VDD



Paul writes:

nother Jaguar (my sixth) followed me home in September, a 1990 V12 Vanden Plas. The first owner lived in British Columbia. Canada and traded this car in for a new Jaguar in 2003. After passing through several ownerships, it was sold in 2004 to the third owner who lived in the San Jose area and who imported it into the USA. cessful registration required extensive work with the Environmental Protection Agency and the California Air Resources Board because none of these cars were ever sold new in the USA. I found this car was for sale in March though some Jaguar enthusiast friends. By coincidence (fate?), Debby and I were in San Jose in September to visit

our son and his family, and I made arrangements to see the car. Jaguar stopped selling the Series III XJs in the USA in 1987, but they continued selling them in the rest of the world until 1991. This car could not be purchased new in the USA. There are several features different from Series III Vanden Plas cars sold in the USA that are sure to keep the judges on their toes. The Jaguar Racing Green exterior/Magnolia interior was a special order color combination believed to be the only one in existence. I had an uneventful and amazingly smooth and quiet 500 mile drive home from San Jose to Ramona on 8 September (the day of the big power outage), and then shortly afterwards I brought my new 1990 V12 Vanden Plas to the 2 October British Car Day where it won one of the three trophies awarded to Jaguars that day. It's a beautiful car and one that I will proudly enter in many car shows in the future. I plan to work on it over the winter and then compete it in the JCNA 2012 concours season.







### Where in the World was Haley Holmes?



#### That Jaguar moment...

I suppose everyone has that moment. The one where you suddenly see a Jaguar and say: "Yep, that's the car for me." I've never had that moment with any other car, just so you know. And it's a moment that I'll always remember.

Although born just outside the factory gates in Coventry, as my Dad likes to tell people, I don't have any recollections of Jaguars until my teen years in San Diego.

By then, I was driving an MGTD that my Dad and I had

restored from the ground up. It was a beautiful little car, a pale yellow one, and I took great pride in driving and maintaining it.



It was that pride that got me be-

hind the wheel of my first Jaguar: a beautiful pale yellow XKE. At the time, I was working at a little car wash down on Morena Boulevard.

Talk about a slow and boring business! We had so little to do that the owner – a former Navy guy – had us using tooth picks to clean grains of dirt out of the sprayers. I'm sure it was important work.

At the job, I used to make a point of parking my MG in the same spot every day, a place in the sun where everybody could see it. I guess that's why the guy came into the car wash with his Jag.

Up he rolled. This was in the summer of 1965. E-Types were new then, and this one was brand new. Yellow. It purred to a stop. The door opened. The driver hopped out.

"Who owns that MG over there?" he asked. All the other car wash guys looked at me. "I do," I said. "Okay, then," he said. "You're the guy who's gonna take care of my car today."

The other guys shot me envious looks. No more toothpick patrol for me.

He had me hop in the car, and drove it back over to his work. He got out. "Okay, Kid. It's all yours. Come back at 4 this afternoon. Washed and waxed."

Was I in heaven or was I in heaven? I slid back into the car: This time behind the wheel. I switched on the engine. It roared to life. I pressed in the clutch, put 'er in first, and slowly exited the parking lot.

I wanted that drive back to the car wash to last forever. I wanted it to be as fast as possible, too. I wanted that afternoon to last forever. I wanted that car to last forever, too.

I just loved that car. It stayed with me long after I drove it back to its owner. Years and years after. It was clean through and through. It sparkled. It



shone. It purred. It was mine for a day. Age 17, if you know what I mean.

Over the years, I have never forgotten that day. My little MG, long gone now, was the ticket to my one and only drive in a Jaguar. E-Types came and went, too. But the memory stayed.

Years later, I began to notice those new Jags – the XK8's and XKR's. They took me back to that first drive. In the new cars, I saw the past and it was the summer of 1965 all over again.

That yellow Jag. My XKR is as shapely as that XKE. It's platinum. But somewhere inside of me doesn't quite believe that. Inside, I'm sure it's really yellow.

What's that painting by Salvadore Dali? The Persistence of Memory? That's my moment... what's yours?





### San Diego Jaguar Club Board of Directors Meeting Minutes November 16, 2011

The meeting was called to order at Vision Pulse Creative Event & Meeting Center at 6:30 pm by the President, Stick Holmes. The following board members were present: Vic Chang, Mike Smith, Dan Jensen, Nedra Rummell, Grant Rummell, Craig McLaughlin, and Dannie McLaughlin. George Klein was also in attendance.

Secretary's Report. The minutes of the October meeting were unanimously approved via e-mail by the Board members prior to the meeting.

Treasurer's Report. The Treasurer reported that, compared to 2010, income is up, expenses are down, and overall the Club is in a healthy position financially. Advertising revenue continues to be strong and membership numbers are holding strong as well.

First Vice President's Activities Report. Events Review: Dan reported that the drive to Borrego Springs was a success with 23 people in attendance. Board members enjoyed the fact that one price covered both lodging and the Saturday evening dinner expenses; there was also a good turnout for the Election Dinner at Phil's Barbeque, where the slate of officers and revised Club bylaws were approved unanimously. Events Preview: 12/17 - The Holiday Party will be at Trellises, at a cost of \$50 per person with the Club providing appetizers and wine before the dinner. Paul will retain the trophy case in his garage until Jaguar San Diego has completed their dealership showroom; 5) the Board again discussed new brochures. With regard to printing costs, Stick will follow-up with Allegra and JCNA, Dannie will follow-up with a source she has, Nedra will follow-up with Vista Print and a representative from Vision Pulse will also provide the Club with a bid.

New Business – 1) The Board discussed the benefits of using PayPal or credit cards to pay for memberships, Club events, and to purchase Club logo items, and were in agreement that Grant and Nedra should investigate the costs associated with these options and report back to the Board at the next meeting.
