Another goal is to push the membership over the 200 number that we just flirt with every year. With two new dealerships in San Diego county, I hope for even more interest in our favorite marque.


I'll work real close with the membership chairman to push for new members, but will be gentle as I know who cooks my dinner tonight.




SDJC's Gala Event The Holiday Party





Where in the World were Kathleen Steele, and Paul Novak?



British Tool Kits finally Explained

This was sent in by Paul Novak. He said earlier this year he noticed a sign which was part of the tool kit display on a MK V at British Card Day. This is what it said:

1951 JAGUAR MK-V SALOON (Sedan to Americans)

TOOL COMPARTMENT

All Jaguar Mark-V saloons were built and sold with fully-equipped tool compartments as you see below. The purpose for such equipment is often misunderstood by Americans at car shows. Sometimes they make crude and insensitive jokes about unreliable Jaguar cars needing such tools all the time. The tools were NOT provided because Jaguar cars often required their application. Indeed, this was very seldom the case, as the negligible sign of use on the tools below clearly testifies.

In the case of the Jaguar Mark-V cars exported to the United States the tools were provided so that charitable Jaguar Drivers would be properly equipped when they stopped to assist American drivers whose Detroit products were broken-down on the side of the road. This generous and thoughtful planning on the part of the Jaguar Company was solely intended as a subtle gesture of appreciation for American aid, however slight, in helping the British Empire to win World War Two.

The glamorous XK-150 as seen by Rene Bouche

Nigel Thorley, writing in his influential book Jaguar: Marketing the Marque, has some fascinating things to say about the role of advertising as a new model car develops into an old one.

Jaguar's XK series, which debuted in 1948, was by 1957 becoming a familiar sight even on the roads of the United States. Even then, company policy was to introduce ranges of models based on the same theme.

According to Thorley, that was an ideal way to "expand the market, increase production, and bring down unit costs." Similarly, advertising these variant models had a strategy of its own.

As the models mature and need regular upgrading, Thorley says that less emphasis is given to publicity, particularly if the cars are selling very well without it or money is being directed into an entirely new replacement project.

"Such was the case with the XK 150, as the XK theme was now in the September of its years," says Thorley, adding that "there was still plenty of life left in the model, but the brochures, although adequate, were not of the highest standard."

You'd never know it from the magazine ads of the period, especially for the XK-150 Gran Turismo Hardtop Coupe. Indeed, one can hardly find an ad more compelling that one produced by Rene Bouche for the new model.

Bouche was among the most successful and original illustrators of his time. Indeed, for much of his career, Bouche was a leading illustrator for Vogue magazine, as well as Saks Fifth Avenue and Elizabeth Arden.

The sense of elegance that Bouche delivered for those advertisers carried over into his work for Jaguar.

Even today, one has to stand back in admiration of Bouche's ad for the XK-150 Gran Turismo Hardtop Coupe. The sense of elegance is conveyed by a number of features in the illustration, not least the formal attire of the (apparent) owners of the car.

Have they just arrived at the docks from an evening on the town? Are they greeting someone aboard the luxurious cruise liner? Whatever the couple is doing, they are doing it with a Jaguar XK-150.

This may well be the end of the XK line as introduced in 1948, but that's not the feeling conveyed here. Indeed, Bouche's ad makes the XK-150 look like a "must have" vehicle for anyone who wants to be seen as anyone.

Yet, even as this is a pitch for elegance, the ad writ-

er reminds readers of the marque's racing heritage, saying that "Jaguar competition cars recently have achieved the most dramatic victories on the entire history of racing" – a reference to Le Mans victories in 1955, 1956 and 1957 in addition to 1951-53.



But the racing heritage is now linked to the sophisticated market: "These tests of endurance are the proving grounds for Jaguar dependability and safety, now combined with classic styling and incomparable elegance in the Jaguar XK-150 sports touring car."

Jaguar historian Eric Dymock notes that the greatest asset of the XK-150 was actually just "the catalogued inclusion of disc brakes, a legacy of motor racing."

The ad writer notes that, too: "This Jaguar ensures you the maximum safety of four-wheel disc brakes, the first production line car in the world to be so equipped."

But brakes are the last thing on anyone's mind in viewing this ad, which really calls to mind that great old line: "What an elegant, swelegant party this is."

Who would not want to be part of that? And that's the genius of Bouche's vision of the XK-150 – a line of car in the twilight of its history.
