



LOU TRIPI - A GREAT FRIEND AND SDJC MEMBER

January 20, 1948 - January 25, 2014

Sometimes in life you meet people who you can really relate to on many levels. We met Lou and Annemarie Tripi at one of the SDJC dinners and immediately became great friends.

Lou was a true car guy ... Jaguar XKR Coupe, 1966 Corvette Coupe, Audi A7, and Shelby Cobra etc. We also had a Jaguar, '67 Corvette and an Audi! He was also a NASCAR fanatic, attending many races. He was a serious boater

and had often raced his Formula power boat successfully. He even taught us how to handle our power boat without totally wrecking the marina every time we docked.

But Lou had many other aspects that bonded us together. He was a real family man with great love for his two sons Darin and Chad and his 4 grandchildren. Bringing up two children ourselves and having two grandchildren, we had much to chat about including schooling siblings to take over our businesses. Lou had a great sense of humor, the only problem being that with Sue and I coming from the UK, and Lou with his Italian - New York accent, we could not always tell what he was saying. we would ask Annemarie to translate which often caused much laughter.

Lou was a real entrepreneur and started his own business at the age of 25, having decided that he should use his Bachelor's degree in Business Administration and Accounting. Lou and Annemarie working very hard out of a trailer, bought two used dump trucks to start a haulage business. Today, the aggregate material hauling company is one of the largest of its kind in Western New York State with 26 tri axle dump trucks, several trailers, low boys and high lifts etc. A tough business requiring long hours was the routine. As business owners ourselves we could relate to the challenges of running a business in today's environment.

Six years ago Lou and Annemarie bought a lovely home in North County where they planned to eventually retire. For several years, the demands of the business meant they had to postpone their retirement. They would come out here for the winters and enjoy numerous SDJC events. Finally, last fall they were nearly retired and left the running of the business to their son Chad in Buffalo.

Lou was born in Buffalo on January 20th 1948 and died on January 25, 2014 just a few months after finally beginning to retire. He died of Pancreatic Cancer. Lou was one of our dearest friends, and best human beings we have ever met in our lifetime, and he will be sorely missed as long as we live. There is a story to be told someday, about Lou and his tossing pennies to the ground to wish the finders good luck. The next time you find a penny on the ground, you can be sure it came from Lou in Heaven! Thank you Lou for all you taught us and the fun we had together. Thank you SDJC for introducing Annemarie and Lou to us.

Annemarie is currently back in Buffalo helping Chad run the business and she is in our hearts every single day.

Remembering Orson, The Legacy Continues

from archives of the

San Diego Jaguar Club* and San Diego Zoo

Early in 1979, someone in the Club realized that the "World Famous" San Diego Zoo was in need of help regarding the endangered jaguars. A campaign was started to raise funds for the jaguar exhibit. Donations were solicited from the Jaguar-Rover-Triumph Group and West Coast Distributors, and fees charged to the public for admission to our 1979 Concours d'Elegance were pledged to this cause. Checks totaling \$2,000 were presented by SDJC President, Randy Prine, to Joan Embry, the Zoo's famous roving ambassador, at the closing dinner of our 1979 Concours. Contributions included \$500 from Jaguar-Rover-Triumph, \$500 from West Coast Distributors, and \$800 from admission fees to the Concours. The club dipped into our treasury for \$200 to round out the total to \$2,000.

Two more cubs were born in 1985 and were subsequently loaned to a zoo in Atascadero, CA in 1986. Finally, three cubs were born in 1989 and loaned to a zoo in New York. All of these loans eventually became permanent adoptions. Orson was born in 1992 and came to the San Diego Zoo from a wild life center in Phoenix, Arizona. Not an organization that would donate for a Jaguar exhibit program and then not see to its maintenance, SDJC began making annual donations for the Zoo's jaguars a few years after Black Jack arrived.
