GRANT RUMMELL



Grant Rummell passed away November 11, 2014, after a short battle with cancer. With him passed a 15-year era of contributions to SDJC. Those of you who knew him and perhaps worked with him on the SDJC Board of Directors (BOD) remember his keen business acumen coupled with an infectious sense of humor and joie de vivre. Without a doubt, Grant lived life large and SDJC benefited in countless ways from the generous donation of his time and talents.

Grant's affinity for Jaguars began with a blue E-Type 2 + 2 and led to the eventual ownership of 15 Jaguars over the ensuing years. Having a desire to become more involved with the marque, he and Nedra joined SDJC in May of 1997. It took less than 18 months for them to become involved with club activities by participating in the Event Phone Chain, an important function at a time before e-mail was prevalent. In March 2001, Grant was elected 1st Vice President, and then served as a BOD member in 2003-2004. In 2005, he was elected Treasurer, a position he held for the next nine years, with only a brief interruption in 2012 when he served as SDJC President. In addition to these responsibilities, Grant and Nedra hosted countless events for the club: the annual New Members' Dinner at the St. Mark Country Club, the annual Holiday Party, numerous drives and dinner events, and even SDJC BOD meetings at their home.

An old saying in business is, "If you want to get a job done, give it to a busy person". Grant certainly personified this advice. He managed to squeeze his many club activities into a wide-reaching and successful business career. He was CEO of Nortek's Linear security, audio, video and home automation group for 23 years, during which time he acquired close to 25 brands that evolved and prospered under his guidance and oversight. This experience and long-term perspective was extremely beneficial to SDJC as well, where he helped ensure the financial stability of club operations while assisting with the continued growth of club membership.

I had the pleasure of serving on the BOD with Grant over the past seven years. He kept a close watch on club finances, but always with a clear sense of where funds should be allocated to best benefit the SDJC membership. I also recall many times when a smile would start to creep across his face as he prepared to fire off another zinger that got us all laughing uproariously. The SDJC BOD meetings and club events are not the same without his ever present wit and engaging banter with Nedra.

Grant will be honored at the SDJC Holiday Party as the 2014 Most Valuable Member, an acknowledgement of his many contributions this year and those in years past.

Tim Bennett reports: I recently joined Porsche Club of America Orange County chapter as I've owned a 911 SC for 28 years. However the main reason for joining was I learned they hold monthly Auto Cross (autoX) events at the old El Toro Marine Base and welcome cars other than Porsche's. I attended the event in September as an observer to learn the ropes and what I needed in order to take my 2012 XKR and let it loose.

After purchasing the appropriate specification helmet and registering online for a permanent competition number I was ready to go for the October event. Unless you've done 4 or more events, one is considered a Novice and required to have a PCA Club instructor with you, not just to ensure the loonies don't get behind the wheel but to provide important coaching on autoX techniques in order to be smooth and fast. Yahoooooo - let me tell you it was absolutely wonderful to open up all 510 hp without any safety and speeding ticket concerns.

The day consisted of two 4 laps practice sessions in the morning and 4 timed heats in the afternoon on the approximately mile and quarter course laid out with cones. I had trouble on the first 3 runs getting the XKR to rotate quickly in tight corners until my instructor and I came to the conclusion I was fighting the DCS traction control. Turning it off made all the difference in the world while providing a much more heart thumping drive. I'm registered for the November 16th event and just can't wait to hit the throttle when the flag drops.

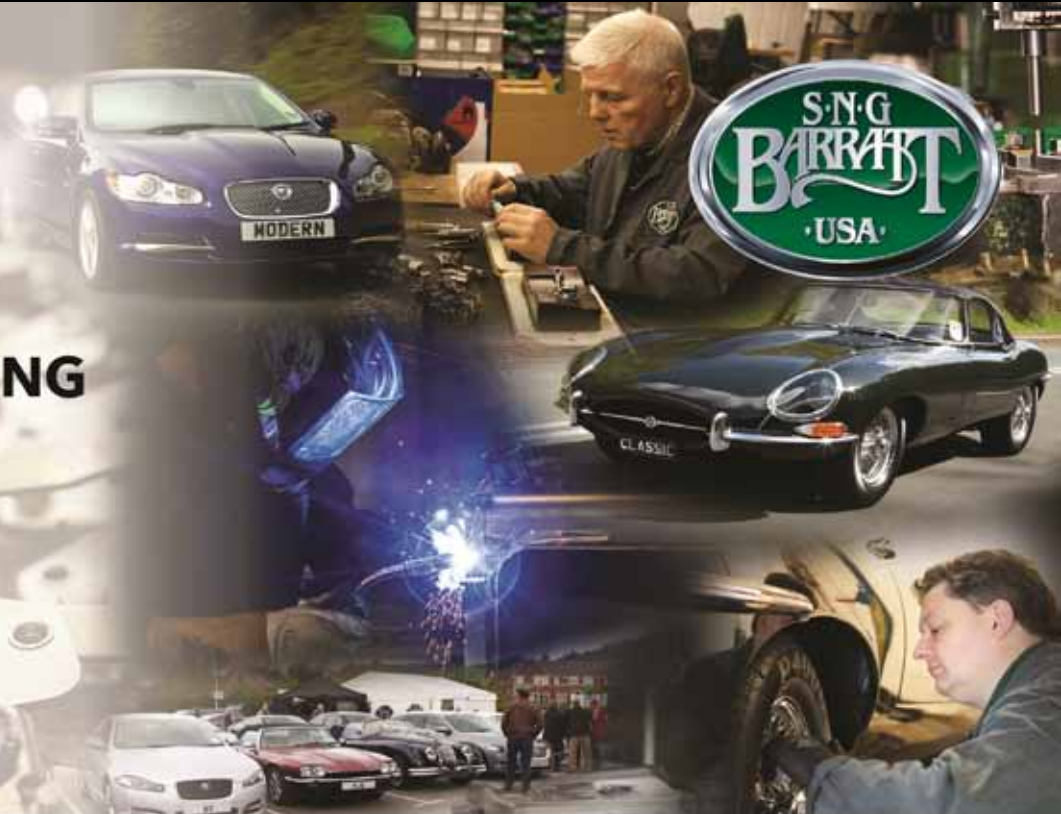

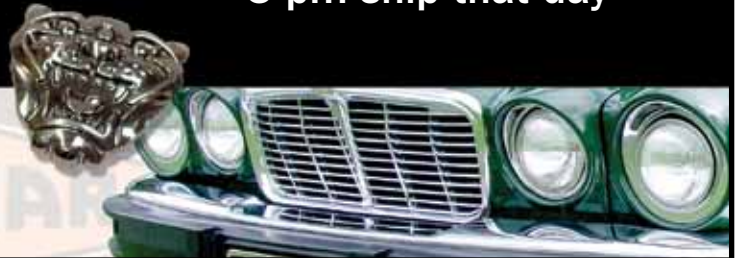

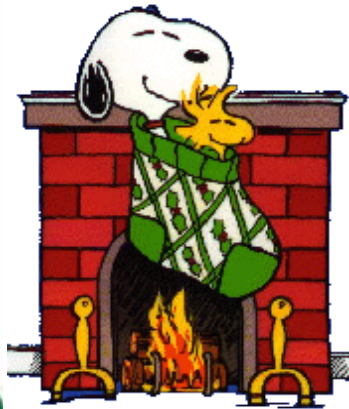
