

Directions to SDJC Concours

Spanish Landing is on the south side of Harbor Drive directly across from the Terminal 2 exit from San Diego International Airport (Lindbergh Field). From I-5, follow the signs to the Airport. This will place you westbound on Harbor Drive. Go past the Terminal 1 and Harbor Drive traffic signals and watch for the Spanish Landing signs. Turn left into the park at the traffic signal for the exit from Terminal 2. There will be San Diego Jaguar Club Signs marking the location.



The San Diego Jaguar Club plans this as a show and a picnic. If you are traveling from out of town and cannot pack a picnic lunch, box lunches can be pre-ordered on the registration form, and soft drinks and water will be available for purchase on site for \$1.

Overnight motor home and trailer parking is not allowed in Spanish Landing Park. There are county, state, and privately operated parks that accommodate overnight stays. One such is De Anza Harbor Resort at 2727 De Anza Rd., about seven miles from Spanish Landing (619-273-3211). There is often space past the west end of the Concours field that can accommodate day-of-show trailer and tow vehicle parking. If available, space is allotted on a first-come, first-served basis.

F-Type Weekend !!!

... What a Difference Six Decades Makes

We met at our Jaguar Dealer, San Diego European Motorcars, at the last SDJC drive to Vintana restaurant. Members politely listened to General Mgr. Richard Farler expound on the attributes of the F-type and other Jaguar models while enjoying coffee and pastries. At the end of his short presentation, he announced the raffle prize – weekend use of a new F-Type, *won by me!* Hey, Deborah and I were going to Palm Springs anyway the next weekend, why not in a new F-type, top-down.

We showed up on Thursday afternoon in our '83 XJ6 (driver as of late). We had been on the previous weekend's drive in a '54 XK-120 and now, being brought up for us, was a 2014 Stratus Grey 380 HP Supercharged V6 F-Type. Vernon Honore, Sales Manager, showed us the rudimentary controls, then we backed up to the XJ6 to load up the luggage. The boot is quite compact in the F-Type. We loaded up tight: 1 carry-on size rolling suitcase (Hers), 1 squashed duffle bag (Mine), 3 shirts on a hanger, with maybe enough room left over for a couple pair of shoes. Room behind the seats: possibly 2 magazines.

With Vernon anxiously watching, we peeled out of the dealership onto Convoy. The car sounded great! We had the JaguarDrive control set to Dynamic Mode "to deliver a high performance driving experience". What that means is the exhaust is engineered to sound incredibly great and loud - really one of the best features!

We headed out on the 52 to I-15 North, cruising up to Nussy Burger off Pala Road/Hwy 76 in about a half hour. We then

headed to Temecula, past the strip malls, through Anza till we got to SR74, (Pines to Palms Scenic Byway) thru the mountain on the winding road with great hairpin curves to enjoy and wonderful views of the Coachella Valley, top down on a sunny day. Really, driving fast isn't the big thrill, it's getting 0-60 in about 4.5 seconds, and 30 to 50 in about 2.5 seconds. As we made the turn onto SR 371 from the Temecula Parkway intersection, I pushed the accelerator about half way down, got to 50 mph in about 4 seconds and flew along past a CHP officer. Oops! But, the speed limit there is 50 anyway, we just got there really fast. No brakes needed going downhill with this car, the eight speed gearbox can slow you down a little or a lot, the paddle shifters being the way to go.



The overlook on the mountain was fantastic, and a great road to drive down. The next night, we blasted back up the mountain to the overlook - lots of fun the whole way, even accelerating between stop lights with an Asian car on the way back - sorry buddy, the Jag is too fast.

PLUSES: Gorgeous design, passenger comfort, great engine, and a better exhaust note.

If you are a seasoned concours Entrant, I hope this will help you enjoy it more. If you have never participated, I hope this will encourage you to join in the fun.

Looking for a Few Good Women and Men for Concours Judges.

Preparations are underway for our 19 July Concours d'Elegance and we are looking for members who are interested in becoming concours Judges and also former JCNA certified Judges who wish to help out again and get recertified. We would like to grow our current list of 9 certified Judges to at least a dozen or more by concours day. We lost several of our certified Judges over the past few years due to a variety of reasons and we are definitely looking for a few good women and men to become certified JCNA Concours Judges. 
