





Directions to SDJC Concours

Spanish Landing is on the south side of Harbor Drive directly across from the Terminal 2 exit from San Diego International Airport (Lindbergh Field). From I-5, follow the signs to the Airport. This will place you westbound on Harbor Drive. Go past the Terminal 1 and Harbor Drive traffic signals and watch for the Spanish Landing signs. Turn left into the park at the traffic signal for the exit from Terminal 2. There will be San Diego Jaguar Club Signs marking the location.



The San Diego Jaguar Club plans this as a show and a picnic. If you are traveling from out of town and cannot pack a picnic lunch, box lunches can be pre-ordered on the registration form, and soft drinks and water will be available for purchase on site for \$1.

Overnight motor home and trailer parking is not allowed in Spanish Landing Park. There are county, state, and privately operated parks that accommodate overnight stays. One such is De Anza Harbor Resort at 2727 De Anza Rd., about seven miles from Spanish Landing (619-273-3211). There is often space past the west end of the Concours field that can accommodate day-of-show trailer and tow vehicle parking. If available, space is allotted on a first-come, first-served basis.

All entrants are requested to bring a fire extinguisher.



This article provides information about the Jaguar Clubs of North America (JCNA) Concours d'Elegance Program to help you understand more about this interesting aspect of Jaguar ownership. If you are a seasoned concours Entrant, I hope this will help you enjoy it more. If you have never participated, I hope this will encourage you to join in the fun and excitement.

2015 Concours Rule Book Changes: Here are some of the significant changes to the JCNA Concours Rule Book approved at the 2015 JCNA Annual General Meeting that will be in effect for our 19 July Concours. The 2015 Concours Rule Book can be downloaded for free from the Concours page of the JCNA website or a hard copy ordered through the JCNA website Merchandise page for \$12 plus shipping.

- 1 Consolidation of Concours Judging Classes: A consolidation was made to address the lack of participation in some classes where very few cars have competed over the past several years. Champion Division classes were reduced from 26 to 20, Driven Division from 16 to 15 and Special Division from 4 to 3. For a listing of the new class structure, please refer to our updated concours registration information elsewhere in Jaguar Tracks or the form located on the concours page of the SDJC website calendar.
- 2 The Certification Process for New Judges and Certification Renewal for All Judges: "Note: A passing grade, for the Judge's Test, requires answering at least 45 of the 50 questions correctly."
- 3 Number of Certified Judges. "Beginning in 2015, all Judges for Champion, Driven and Special Divisions must hold current JCNA judging certifications."
- 4 Judging Time Limit. "Note: The 15 minute time limit does not include the time to conduct the Operation Verification (OV) inspection nor the time required to explain authenticity discrepancies to the Entrant and obtain his or her initials for them."
- 5 Authentic Options. "Authentic options are listed in official Jaguar publications or official Jaguar sales literature. Only written proof from those sources, from JCNA approved Judging Guides or from specific portions of JCNA Seminar Technical Bulletins is acceptable in validating such items. Factory items offered as standard must be correct for the year and model presented. (See Chapter VI, A.4 and Appendices C& E.)"
- 6 Operation Verification (Functional Only). "Note 2: LED replacement bulbs. There will be no penalty for replacing original light bulbs with LED's. However, the exteriors and lenses of all lights/lamps must appear as original/authentic.", "Note 3. Dim lights still constitute acceptable function." and "Note 2: Factory, and Jaguar USA authorized LED daytime running light strips and/or other linear LED configurations, must have at least 50% of their individual lengths functional."
- 7 Chassis, Body Posture, and Ride Height. "Examine the Entry's body posture to determine that the car stands as level as you have been accustomed to seeing. Neither the front nor the rear should be excessively high or low. The differences may frequently be noted by comparing the vertical distance between the tops of the tires and the lower edge of the wheel arch. It is common for cars to be presented with misadjusted torsion bars and or rear leaf springs that are worn and sagging or, in contrast, leaf springs that have been re-arced or replaced and cause the rear of the car to sit too high."

2015 Concours Judges Training. Here are the concours related training classes offered this year.

- <u>Concours 101 Introduction to JCNA Concours</u>. Saturday 9 May from 1:30 PM 3:30 PM at the San Diego Automotive Museum. Includes a class
 room presentation, show and tell, and informal discussion of JCNA concours for those unfamiliar with concours but interested in learning about it.
 No experience or preparation is required, only an interest in learning about JCNA concours.
- <u>Concours 201 Hands-On Practice Judging.</u> Saturday 6 June 9:00 AM 12:30 PM at Jaguar San Diego, 4525 Convoy St., San Diego, CA. This
 is a new class to get Apprentice Judges, and Judges with expired certification, up to speed so that they can participate as Certified Judges at our
 2015 concours. Experience as an Apprentice Judge or past JCNA Certified Judge is required. Includes hands-on practice judging of participants
 Jaguars using score sheets, Rule Books and Judge's Guides. Prior experience and some review of the Rule Book is required before attending.
- <u>Concours 301 Annual Judges Refresher Training</u>. Saturday 9 May at the San Diego Automotive Museum from 9:00 AM 12:30 PM and Saturday 20 June at Classic Showcase in Oceanside from 9:00 AM 12:30 PM. This is the formal Judges Refresher Training required each year by JCNA to recertify Judges for the current concours year and includes a detailed classroom PowerPoint presentation, a review of the JCNA Concours Rule Book and discussions of the latest Rule Book changes for 2015. The written 2015 Judges Test will be administered. Everyone is welcome to attend these sessions as they are an excellent way for Judges and Entrants alike to learn more about the JCNA Concours Rules.




