




News from Members





Best in Show and winner in Class C1/PRE at the 51st Annual SDJC Concours d'Elegance is this beautifully restored 1935 SS1 Tourer.

The car was a true labor of love. Owners Colin Seid, Allan Seid, and Richard Annis, report the SS1 was found in Florida after spending more than 30 years, unrestored and in pieces, at the Museum of Transportation in St. Louis. The car arrived in California in boxes, wrapped for shipment as you see in the photo above. Two years of meticulous restoration has brought the car to its present concours winning condition. It is believed to be one of only five survivors of this model in existence today.






