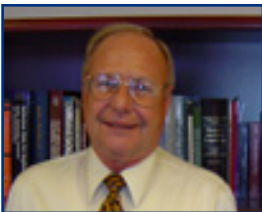

A Personal Statement

We all know Ian Callum as the Chief Stylist at Jaguar. He is responsible for some of the most beautiful Jaguar designs of recent years, most notably the XJ, XF, XK, F-Type and the new XE and F-Pace. His concept cars, especially the C-X75, have been real show stoppers at the major international auto shows world wide. Like all of us, he has his personal dream cars; classic Jaguars that, if he could redesign them for today's world, they would reflect his own personal tastes.

The car shown on these pages is a Mark 2 Ian commissioned Classic Motor Cars Limited to build for him. He says owning a Mark 2 was a boyhood aspiration, a childhood dream. Now his dream has come true. The scope of the build is extensive (rack and pinion steering, 5 speed Tremec, and a custom engineered independent rear suspension system to name a few highlights). All the details can be found in the brochure for the vehicle on CMC's website at www.classic-motor-cars.co.uk. The car was received so well upon completion in 2014, Ian gave CMC permission to make eleven more. Before you run to get your checkbook, download the brochure and see just how much re-engineering went into the two year project. Then be prepared to spend, hold your breath, approximately \$600,000 for your very own Mark 2 by Callum.

Here Comes ^{the} Judge

This article provides information about the Jaguar Clubs of North America (JCNA) Concours d'Elegance Program to help you understand more about this aspect of Jaguar ownership. If you are a seasoned concours Entrant, I hope this will help you enjoy it more. If you have never participated, I hope this will encourage you to join in the fun.

2015 SDJC Concours Analysis: I provided a list of the provisional scores for the 35 judged Entries at our Concours in the September Jaguar Tracks. This month I took a deeper look at the Entrants, Entries, Judges and other facets of our Concours and came up with these interesting facts:

- There were 58 Entries registered for our 9 August Concours, 36 Judged Entries and 22 for Display.
- There were 2 no-shows, 1 judged Entry broke down on the way to the Concours and 1 Display car had an accident a few days before the Concours and was being repaired.
- There were 24 SDJC Entries (69%), 8 Jaguar Owners Club of LA Entries (23%), 1 Jaguar Club of Southern Arizona Entry (3%), 1 Rocky Mountain Jaguar Club Entry (3%), and 1 Entry from the Jaguar Club of Mexico (3%).
- Of the 35 Entries that were judged, 18 were in Champion Division and 17 were in Driven Division.
- A 2016 F-Type was the newest Entry and a 1935 SS1 was the oldest Entry spanning 81 years.
- Two Entries received perfect scores, Mitch & Parvin Cohen's 2014 F-Type (100.00 in C20/F) and Dave & Jocelyn Kelley's 1995 XJS convertible (10.0 in D9/XJS).
- There were two Classes with 4 Entries, the early E-Types (C5/E1) and the XK120/XK140 (D1/PRE).
- There was one Class with 3 Entries, the early Small and Large Saloons (C8/SLS)
- There were five Classes with 2 Entries, the XK120s (C2/120), the XK8s (C12/K8), the F-Types (C20/F), the E-Types (D2/E1) and the facelift XJSs (D9/XJS).
- There were fourteen Classes with only 1 Entry, all (40%) receiving uncontested First Place Awards.
- Eight Entries (23%) received First Place Awards while competing against others in their Class.
- Eight Entries (23%) received Second Place Awards while competing against others in their Class.
- Three Entries (9%) received Third Place Awards while competing against others in their Class.
- Two Entries (6%) came in Fourth Place and did not receive a trophy.
- There were 20 Judges, 9 from SDJC (45%), 8 from Jaguar Owners Club of LA (JOCLA) (40%), 2 from Inland Empire Jaguar Club (IEJC) (10%) and 1 from Jaguar Club of Southern Arizona (JCSA) (5%). We had more Judges from other clubs (55%) than SDJC (45%) at our Concours.
- We had 20 Judges, 2 Scrutineers reviewing score sheets, and 3 Scorekeepers verifying and calculating the scores and standings. There were no Apprentice Judges participating in our Concours this year.

Looking for a Few Good Women and Men for Concours Judges.

Preparations are already in work for our 2016 Concours d'Elegance and we are looking for members interested in becoming Certified Concours Judges. We would like to grow our current list of 12 SDJC Judges by three more Judges by Concours day 2016. We lost some of our experienced Judges over the past few years due to a variety of reasons and we are looking for a few good women or men to become Judges. I will be offering Concours Training classes again in May and June for those interested in learning more about JCNA Concours or becoming Judges.

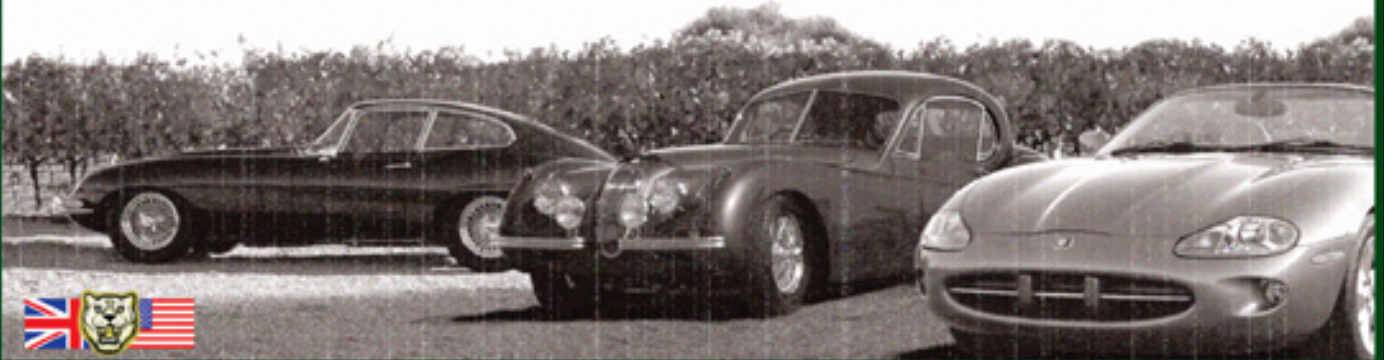

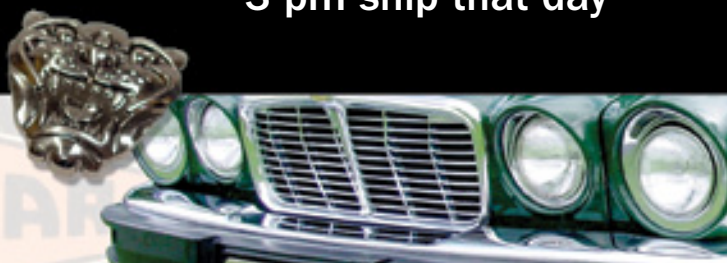
