

The San Diego Jaguar Club brought two dozen Jags to the show. The company and weather were superb and all had a great time. We certainly will be back next year.



















The Night Before Christmas*



'Twas the night before Christmas, at Garage Majal, and everything's well with Chief Judge Paul.


His Jaguars tucked in all safe and secure, already being prepped for next year's Concours.
