Presidential Perspective

I'm writing this as I relax after the SDJC 52nd Annual Concours last weekend at Spanish Landing. Well, relaxing is a relative term. As I noted last month, Mark Hodges took over as Concours Chair this year and he did the heavy lifting of managing this very successful event. I'm sure he is doing the real relaxing, knowing that he did a great job. The weather was perfect, there were ~20 Jaguars on display, and over 35 entered for judging. Paul Novak, SDJC Chief Judge, did his usual masterful job of coordinating the efforts of 20 Judges, three Scorekeepers, and five Scrutineers/Apprentice Judges (Dave Allen, Rick Annis, Bob Huntoon, Will Nighswonger, and Doug Todd). This is an annual task that requires many hours on Paul's part to ensure the correct judges are assigned to the appropriate judged classes. He would be the first to agree that he couldn't succeed without the dedicated support of judges from SDJC, Jaguar Owners Club of Los Angeles, Inland Empire Jaguar Club, and even one judge from the Nation's Capital Jaguar Owners Club. George Klein, Concours "Parking Czar", and his team ensured the field was laid out and ready for entrants as they started to roll in. I was particularly glad to see a new member on the concours team, Vito Arminio, who recently purchased an F-Type and then jumped into supporting the Concours.

Jaguar San Diego, our Concours sponsor again this year, provided a new XJ, XF, F-Type and F-Pace for display and drooling. These kept Josh Bott of Jag SD hopping, answering many questions and demonstrating new features, especially for the beautiful F-Pace in what I think was Odyssey Red Metallic. Richard Farler, GM of Jag SD, noted that the F-Pace has been a very big seller for them and Jaguar USA. The arrival later this year of the XE is expected to push Jaguar sales to new levels. It's great to know that unlike so many other British car marques from the past, Jaguar will continue to be a presence for as far into the future as I can see.

While walking the concours field, I was again struck by the variety and beauty of the cars. There were a number of entries in Driven that to me looked like they had just rolled off the assembly line at Browns Lane or Castle Bromwich. While this is more the norm for Champion Division entries, it is really gratifying to see the care and attention that entrants devote to cars they use on a regular basis. This helps confirm that I am not all that abnormal when I spend several hours over a weekend working on the perfect polish job for one of our Jaguars.

I mentioned last month that we had purchased a new-to-us 2011 XJ. With that came the need to let go of one member of our Jaguar pride due to limited parking space. The 2004 XJR pulled the short straw and it was put up for sale. The car was purchased by a buyer in Rhode Island who was looking for a "twin" to his XJR that was totaled when he was rear-ended. He and I passed numerous texts and emails back and forth discussing the XJR and our other Jags. He commented on the quality and information included in the SDJC website (thank you again, Mark Hodges) and began to look for a JCNA club in his area. It is great to know the "SuperCat" will go to a good home and that JCNA may have a new member in the process.

Here's hoping we see you at the Concours Afterglow at the Rancho Santa Fe Golf Club on August 14.

This article provides information about the Jaguar Clubs of North America (JCNA) Concours d'Elegance Program to help you understand more about this aspect of Jaguar ownership. If you are a seasoned concours Entrant, I hope this will help you enjoy it more. If you have never participated, I hope this will encourage you to join in the fun.

2016 SDJC Concours Judges, Scrutineers/Apprentice Judges, and Score Keepers:

In order to hold our concours we needed a lot of dedicated individuals to serve as Judges, Scrutineers/Apprentice Judges and Score Keepers. Because of recent JCNA requirements that all Judges be certified and current, we rely heavily on the Judges from other clubs to provide most of the Judges at our concours. In addition to the Judges, we also needed Scrutineers to review the score sheets for accuracy and to correct errors, and Score Keepers to tabulate the scores.
