



This article provides information about the Jaguar Clubs of North America (JCNA) Concours d'Elegance Program to help you understand more about this aspect of Jaguar ownership. If you are a seasoned concours Entrant, I hope this will help you enjoy it more. If you have never participated, I hope this will encourage you to join in the fun.

**2016 SDJC Concours Reports:** Following our 17 July concours, I reviewed the score sheets, worked with the Judges involved when I found errors or needed clarification, corrected score sheets, mailed all of the original score sheets back to the Entrants, and entered the concours scores and Judges Report on the JCNA website. JCNA officials reviewed my reports and our 2016 concours is now "Official". Here is the link to our 2016 SDJC concours on the JCNA website: http://www.jcna.com/eventresult/new-event-result-rank/209939

Here are some interesting (at least to me) statistics from our 17 July 2016 concours:

- Total number of Entries judged: 36
- Number of Champion Division Entries judged: 21 (58 % of total judged)
- Number of Driven Division Entries judged: 12 (33 % of total judged)
- Number of Special Division Entries judged: 3 (9 % of total judged)
- Number of different concours classes judged: 23
- Number of score sheets reviewed: 132
- Largest number of Entries in a Class: 4 in C5/E1 (Series 1 E-Types), 3 in S2/MOD (highly modified or per sonalized Jaguars) and 3 in D10/K8 (XK8s)
- Number of uncontested single Entry in Class: 14 (39% of the Entries judged received an almost automatic first place because they were the only Entries in their Class)
- Number of perfect scores: There were three perfect scores all in Champion Division (100.00 scores), 1 in C1/PRE (1935 SS1) and two in C5/E1 (Series 1 E-Types)
- Number of tie scores: There were two sets of tie scores. Two Entries in C5/E1 (Series 1 E-Types) received
  First Place tie scores of 100.00, and two Entries in Class C9/XJ (1972 XJ6 and 1990 V12 Vanden Plas)
  received First Place tie scores of 99.95.
- Number of Judges utilized in judging: 20. 1 Judge was from the Nation's Capital Jaguar Club, 2 Judges were from the Inland Empire Jaguar Club, 8 Judges were from the Jaguar Owners Club of Los Angeles, and 9 Judges were from the San Diego Jaguar Club
- Average Workload per Judge (includes judging and having their Entries judged): 5.35 judging events
- Number of scores corrected since the 17 July Award Ceremony: 8 (22%)
- Standings changed since the 17 July Award Ceremony: The C2/120 First Place and Second Place Entries swapped standings due to a score sheet error. The First Place Entry is now the 1954 XK120 Fixed Head Coupe (FHC) owned by Jack Rabell, and Second Place Entry is now the 1951 XK120 Open Two Seat (OTS) owned by Marco de la Barrera. A trophy swap is in progress.

#### My "Final Here Comes the Judge":

The time that I spent as the San Diego Jaguar Club Chief Judge has been challenging and rewarding. However, after four years I have decided to resign and move on to other challenges. My thanks to all the Judges, Score Keepers, Scrutineers, and Entrants for your hard work and also to the SDJC President and the Board of Directors for the opportunity to serve as the San Diego Jaguar Club Chief Judge. I am very proud of what I accomplished. If you are interested in this challenging position, please contact SDJC President Dan Jensen or members of the SDJC Board of Directors. 

# San Diego Jaguar Club Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes - August 10, 2016

The meeting was called to order at Jaguar San Diego at 6:55 p.m. by President, Dan Jensen. The following Board members were present: Bob Proctor; Dave Allen; Ali Proctor; George Klein; Al Steele; Tim Bennett; Lloyd Prosser; Mark Hodges, Webmaster; and Jim Hallameyer, Newsletter Editor. Absent: Nedra Rummell; Vic Chang. Also present: Paul Novak, Chief Judge; Dave Putnam, BCC Rep and Pete Pickslay, SD Automotive Museum. Rep.

Secretary's Report: July 2016 Minutes were approved electronically.

**Treasurer's Report:** Dave presented accounts summary through July 2016. Noticeable this month is a sharp rise in Logo merchandise income. Also a rise in logo expenses to replenish stock - mainly blankets. Comparing income and expense this year with the same time last year: overall club income is about the same and our expenses are reduced over 20% due to the electronic newsletter. The Concours d'Elegance P&L does not yet show the Port Authority deposit return and Paul's out-of-pocket expenses. When those items are included it will show the Concours was approximately cost neutral.

**First Vice President's Activities Report:** Bob - **Events Review – 7/17/16** SDJC 52nd Concours d'Elegance went very well. Mark has identified areas to improve for next year. **Events Preview – 8/14/16** Concours Afterglow at the Rancho Santa Fe Golf Club hosted by Barbara Bray. We have 72 attendees registered and everything is on track. **Upcoming: 9/11/16** SDJC day at the Polo Grounds hosted by George Klein. Car and driver free, guests \$10 on line or \$20 at the door. As always please check SDJC website for news and information on upcoming events.

**Membership Report:** Nedra presented the following prospective members electronically to the Board for approval: RICHARD LAWLER and MASON MONSON. Upon a motion by Ali and seconded by Dave, they were unanimously approved.

**Newsletter Editor's Report:** Jim is working on the Jaguar Tracks September issue. Bob will include hyperlink to Jaguar Tracks in future announcement email blasts. Jim informed the Board that December 2016 will be his last edition of the Jaguar Tracks Newsletter.

**Functional Chair Reports:** Dealer Representative: Jim – No news to report.

**Website:** Mark – Logo Wear page has been updated. **Advertising:** Dan/Mark- Currently we have 5 ads running. Concours: Mark – Will be looking at a date on a Saturday for next year. **Chief Judge:** Paul –There were 8 Concours score corrections so far, including one in C2/120 that required a trophy swap. Paul has 5 new judges certified this year. **Automotive Museum:** Pete – The museum has an extensive library available. September will bring a new display of station wagons and woodies. Also, there will be an Electric Vehicle show at QUALCOMM 9/13 from 10-3. **BCCC:** Dave – British Car day, October 9th at the Embarcadero. Website is up and registration is \$25 online and \$40 at the door. **Logo Wear:** – No report.

Old Business: Jim will work on producing paper copy of newsletter for local advertisers.

**New Business:** The Board discussed a change to the by-laws to allow voting for officers and Board members electronically. The Board agreed not to propose such an amendment.

As there was no further business, a motion was made by Ali and seconded by Bob, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:50 p.m. The next board meeting is scheduled for **September 14, 2016, at 7:00 p.m.** at Jaguar San Diego.


