


SDJC BOD for 2017







San Diego Jaguar Club Board of Directors' Meeting Minutes - November 9, 2016

Meeting was called to order at Jaguar San Diego at 7:01 p.m. by 1st Vice President, Bob Proctor. The following Board members were present: Dave Allen; Nedra Rummell; Ali Proctor; George Klein; Al Steele; Tim Bennett; Mark Hodges, Webmaster; and Jim Hallameyer, Newsletter Editor. Absent: Dan Jensen; Vic Chang. Also present: Chuck Leuthen; and Debbie Bennett.

Secretary's Report: October 2016 Minutes were approved electronically.

Treasurer's Report: Dave presented the accounts summary through October 2016. Overall the accounts are healthy and the cost reductions established by the Board this year are making a positive impact. Overall club expenses are reduced more than 20% due to the electronic newsletter. Club dinners continue to be popular with collections up 20% compared to last year. Note that so far this year the club is running a surplus of \$8,338 compared to an operating loss this time last year of \$3,033. Dave also followed up with the Post Office and closed the bulk mailing account and deposited the refund of \$543.63.

First Vice President's Activities Report: Bob - **Events Preview - 11/13/16** Election Luncheon, Silver Gate Yacht Club hosted by Jim Hallameyer. 61 RSVPs. **Upcoming - 12/4/16** Holiday Party at 94th Aero Squadron hosted by Diane McDonald and Holiday Committee. Bob is working on planning for 2017 events to include: 1/14/17 Run for the Border, 2/12/17 SDJC at the SD Zoo. As always please check SDJC website for current news and information on upcoming events.

Membership Report: Nedra presented the following prospective members to the Board for approval: FRANCIS (FRANK) & CARMEN TEPEDINO. Upon a motion by Ali and seconded by Mark, they were unanimously approved. Nedra will be sending out renewals in the next couple of weeks.

Newsletter Editor's Report: Jim is working on the Jaguar Tracks December issue.

Functional Chair Reports: Dealer Representative: Jim – David Murphy passed away. Kevin Chapman CFO of Shelly Auto Group has said the dealership will be moving to El Cajon in the future. **Website:** Mark – Event reservation forms up and working well. **Advertising:** Mark - 2 paid ads, all others member ads. **Concours:** Mark – No report. **Chief Judge:** No report. **Automotive Museum:** Pete – No report. Nedra presented an Update of the By-laws to the Board. After review they will be presented to membership for approval at next general meeting.

As there was no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:45 p.m.






