


As we close out 2017 we reflect on the good times and especially the great friends that the San Diego Jaguar Club has brought into our lives. God bless us, Everyone!

HAPPY NEW YEAR! Soon, the SDJC Concours Judges' cadre will begin the process to spin-up for the 2018 season. I am pleased report that all our Judges are currently certified as of 2017 year-end. Well done!

Mark your calendars for Refresher Training:

May 12th at the San Diego Auto Museum – Concours 301 session one in the morning, and Concours 101 beginning at 1 PM.

June 16th at Classic Showcase for Concours 301 session two.

Concours 201 (Hands-On practice Judging for Apprentices and optional for Certified Judges) will be scheduled depending on need and interest level.



Work is proceeding on the new XK 120 Judge's Guide.

The team is using collaboration software called Dropbox to efficiently share the large draft files and comments/notes over the Internet among the geographically disbursed reviewers and contributors.

A "Test Drive" of the draft guides is tentatively planned early in 2018 and hosted at Tom Krefetz' Classic Showcase in Oceanside. More to follow on that as plans take form.

As of this writing the plan is as follows: Once the Judging Guides have been "approved" by experts and "tested" by JCNA Judges satisfactorily, Dick Cavicke (JCNA Chief Judge) will present all four Judge's Guide sections to the JCNA Concours d'Elegance Rules Committee for approval, and then present them to the AGM in March 2018. If successfully past that wicket, they would become official Judge's Guides for use by judges in 2019. This is a tremendous effort by all concerned, including not only Dick, but several of our own local XK 120 gurus over these past and coming few months.


