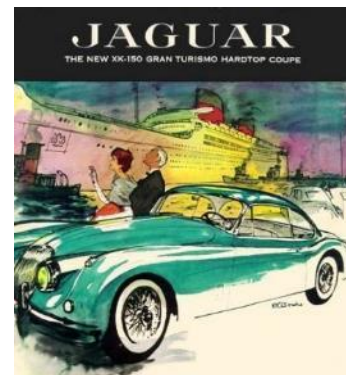

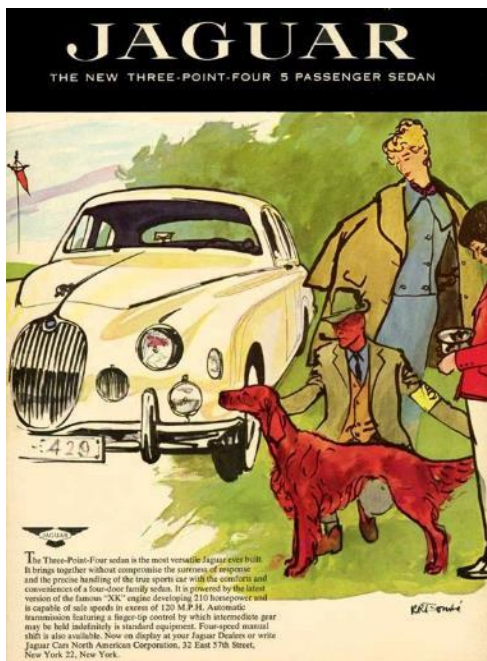

CALL FOR 2019 NOMINEES FOR CLUB OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS

It's election time again!

In accordance with the SDJC By-Laws, the Election Chairperson, Dan Jensen, will develop a list of nominees to fill pending vacancies. Open positions for 2019 include:

- President - open to current or former SDJC Officers and Directors
- First Vice President - open to all SDJC members
- Director (two openings) - open to all SDJC members

Descriptions of responsibilities for each position are available at the SDJC website. Select the *Club Members* tab and look for "Duties of Elected Club Officers". In addition to the descriptions provided therein, officers leaving their position at the end of 2018 will be more than happy to provide advice and counsel to members interested in one of the openings.

Per the club bylaws, the election will be carried out in the following manner:

1. Nominations of Voting Members will be solicited from the general membership by an announcement in the September newsletter to fill each vacancy.
1. The Election Chairperson will publish the slate of nominees in the October issue of the newsletter.
2. Ballots will be handed out to voting members at the November General Membership Meeting.
3. Members will vote within the allotted time.
4. Voting will be closed and ballots will be counted at the meeting by the Secretary and two (2) Members at large OR two (2) other Officers or Directors selected by the President.
5. Those individuals receiving the highest number of votes for each vacancy shall be elected.
6. The results of the election shall be announced at the November General Membership Meeting and published in the December newsletter.

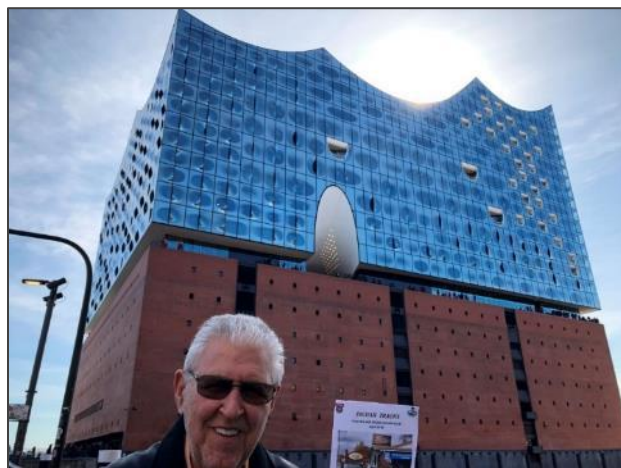

Notes from the Concours Judges Tent

September 2018

Concours Entrants! As you sat next to your beautiful cat(s) at this year's SDJC concours, and perhaps others around the area over the years, have you ever wondered how one becomes a JCNA certified Concours Judge? Well, here's how the process works in SDJC (per JCNA standards):

After rigorous self-study and through participation in the San Diego Jaguar Club's formal Concours Judge Training program, our Apprentices will have completed the necessary pipeline course of instruction and gained the expected proficiency to merit certification.

Training is conducted as required by the JCNA Rule Book. These activities include active participation in three SDJC classes: Concours 101 (Classroom Concours Basics Briefing), Concours 201 (Practice judging under the supervision of the Chief Judge) and Concours 301 (Classroom Refresher Briefing on the contents of the current version of the Rule Book and the content, use and marking of score sheets). Candidates must also pass the JCNA current year Concours Rule Book written test and serve as Apprentice Judges during the SDJC Concours d'Elegance, including marking practice score sheets for two class entries if possible. Concours 201 can serve as a supplemental training/evaluation opportunity.

The Concours 201 session is typically hosted at a member's home. One or two Jaguars are made available for practice judging. The cars are judged to Champion Division standards. The first is judged with no time limit, in order to refresh ourselves on the process and procedures involved, and to provide time for Q&A as we go along - with the team judging together each component in turn. Following critique (and refreshments), a certified judge acts as Team Lead for judging the second car. For this "entry", the 15-minute time limit is observed and each participant judges a specific component (interior and boot, exterior, or engine). A final critique of score sheets and Q&A wraps up a fun and instructive few hours.

If reading these notes has sparked some interest on your part in becoming a JCNA Certified Judge, please get in touch with me – we can ALWAYS use more judges to make our concours events the wonderful experience for which this club is famous.

I am very pleased to announce Diane Bauman is working toward certification as our newest JCNA Concours Judge in SDJC. She completed her first round of apprentice judging during our July 14th Concours, on top of serving her first season as a member of our Scorekeeper team – a double challenge!

This month we are featuring Jim Roberts' 1969 E-Type OTS on the showroom floor at Jaguar San Diego. Jim and Frances have been members of our club since October, 1997, and bring their Jag regularly to club shows and events.

Jim bought the car in January of 1970 from a young Navy fighter pilot friend who purchased the car new, but needed money ... he was getting married. After retiring from a career as a naval aviator, Jim drove this pride and joy regularly, but decided, in 1989, to give it a total restoration.

The engine and drive train were overhauled first followed by a complete body restoration. Jim did all of the dismantling and reassembly himself. He did the paint preparation, but contracted out the final body work, painting, re-chroming and upholstery. Colors are opalescent blue over dark blue leather, the same as when new.

Jim's Jaguar is a twenty-time SDJC Concours d'Elegance winner and was National Jaguar Clubs of North America winner in the Driven class in 1998 and 2004. The car was driven twice to the Central Arizona Concours in Phoenix and several times to various central and northern California concours events. San Diego has been home to the car throughout its life.
