After a week of almost solid rain, the weather gods knew we had plans for a drive and blessed us with one of the prettiest sunny days ever. The group left the starting location at the Grossmont Shopping Center after being given the first poker card of the day. We headed out I-8 east to Greenfield Dr to my lower yard in Granite Hills to collect the second card. From there we headed up Greenfield Drive to Crest and down the hill into Harbison Canyon, Dehesa Road past Sycuan Casino, and Japatul Road.

This is where I made a mistake that routed some in the group further onto Japatul Valley Road due to an error in the instructions. After driving the route at least 6 times, typing still allows for errors. Once the correct right turn was made on Lyons Valley Rd the next stop for poker cards was in a parking lot for the Cleveland National Forest and access to the Japatul Fire Station. The cards had been put out the night before, and luckily were still there. The mis-routed group was able to figure out the error and caught back up with the group.

The drive continued down Honey Springs Road and Otay Lakes Road where every hillside was covered in green grass thanks to all the rain. The scenery was amazingly crisp looking as we drove the twisting roads through the backcountry. The next stop for poker cards was Pio Pico RV Park, which also served as a rest stop for drinks and restroom use. At this point it was obvious that the drive was behind schedule for arriving at the restaurant, and no cell service just complicated things. Bob Proctor was able to get thru to me and relay that we were extremely behind schedule. Otay Lakes Rd then turns into Telegraph Canyon Road, which took us thru Chula Vista Eastlake area.

The group then took the freeways to the I-75 / Palm Ave exit and up the Silver Strand to Coronado, where the Bluewater Grill is across the street from the Hotel Del Coronado. After the re-routed drivers arrived, I moved to bring up the tail of the group and was almost the last to arrive for lunch. The restaurant staff did an excellent job adjusting to the late arrival and then promptly took the lunch orders and served shortly after. The group that was waiting for us at the restaurant at least were able to enjoy the bar while waiting for our late arrival!

Nedra held a raffle drawing and gave away some wonderful prizes. I was thankful for getting the group there, even late, and chose a margarita to drink before lunch. After lunch the last poker card was drawn and everyone was allowed to trade their cards in hopes of bettering their hands. The Scavenger Hunt had both a list of road signs and vehicles to take pictures of. There was one question regarding a doll fence, and for those that missed it, there was a driveway fence of wire that had dolls hanging on it about a foot apart that covered the entire fence on both sides. Quite an odd way to mark their driveway.

The winners of the Scavenger Hunt were given trophies: Nedra & Sara Harding for 1st place, Al & Kathleen Steele for 2nd place, and Steven Bernstein & Gloria Starkey for 3rd place. 




