The Tracks really are a chronological history of how this club has evolved through the years. They are part of our historical archives. You might just get a newfound respect for what our predecessors went through to get us to where we are today; I know I did.



The 2019 JCNA Concours season is upon us. The Los Angeles club's Concours is in May at the Muckenthaler Museum as part of their annual car show and the Inland Empire club's Concours is in October at the Idyllwild Inn. Registrations information and forms are on the Club Member's Page of our website.

Registration is open for our SDJC Concours. I created a new 2019 Concours Page with all the info. Just look for it on the left menu bar. I am excited to announce a few changes. We are moving the show to Cancer Survivor's Park on the east side of Spanish Landing where we will have more room and better grass. You still turn in to the same driveway and parking lot, but once inside, turn left instead of right and go all the way to the end. I have done away with paper registration forms; all registrations are electronic using our Formbuilder Reservation System. This is the same system we currently use for our monthly events. As usual, payment will be by PayPal or by check. There is a separate registration section for judges; this separate database helps with tracking, especially for those judges who do not enter a car in the show and only come down to help judge. For those of you driving a non-Jaguar type car (who owns these things?) to park in the parking lot, you can order an all-day parking lot permit pass so you don't have to go out and keep feeding the meter – it also helps prevent getting a \$40+ parking ticket because you let the meter expire. Just scroll down to the All-Day Parking Lot Permit Section and pay with PayPal.

The rest of our 2019 events have been scheduled and the specifics will be posted as soon as they are finalized.

SDJC's 60TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATION

It was obvious our cats had been pampered as they glistened, grouped together in the spacious parking area. The always amusing Ali Proctor joined me to welcome guests at the check-in table. In addition to the routine entrée cards and name badges, a Trivia Quiz was included in the check-in envelope.



Notes from the Concours Judges Tent

April 2019 By Pete Rieth, Chief Judge, San Diego Jaguar Club



This month, we'll first focus on some "Hot Wash-up" results of the JCNA Annual General Meeting (AGM) 23 March 2019 pertinent to concours judging. These comments are summarized for the sake of brevity. Be sure to read the full minutes text when available on the JCNA website.

AGM 2019 Judge's Concours Rules Committee (JCRC) Activity Summary.

- The Board presented Dick Cavicke the President's Award for Outstanding Achievement. The Certificate recognizes his many, extensive contributions since 2002 as Chair of the Judge's Concours Rules Committee and as JCNA Chief Judge. Nedra Rummell received the Certificate on Dick's behalf.
- XK120 Judging Guide: The delegates reviewed the updated version of the Guide and again gave it conditional approval.
- Hal Kritzman has officially taken on the dual position of Chief Judge of JCNA and Chairman of the Jaguar Concours Rules Committee (JCRC). He has been the Chief Judge of The Jaguar Club of Southern New England for decades and a member of the JCRC with Dick Cavicke since its inception. I have replaced Dick as the Southwest Representative on JCRC.
- The 2019 edition of the JCNA Judge's Guide and its updated Judge's Test are in hand now. I will use them during training of the members of our judge's cadre. Details of changes will be in my next column.

AGM 2019 Concours Committee Summary.

Concours Class Consolidation – Some of the existing Concours classes have little participation, resulting in a lack of competition. JCRC was given a mandate at the 2019 AGM to work with the Concours Committee in structuring a Concours Program that addresses the new direction and future of the Jaguar Marque. Not an easy task, to say the least! Electric and future hybrid models will certainly be changing the look of our concours field more and more as the years fly by and we must design an equitable and fair way to effectively judge them. Hidden motors and no engines have created a new genesis. More to follow in the months ahead. Obviously, changes this significant will not be implemented for the 2019 competitions.

2019 Concours Judges Training.

- Preparations have begun for our Saturday July 13th Concours being held at Spanish Landing Park. Hats
 off to Mark Hodges, our President and Concours Chair (among other things), for doing the many tasks it
 takes to make our event happen! Provided below is a summary of the three types of Concours related
 training that I will offer this year. Please RSVP to me at least 3 days before any class that you plan
 to attend so that there will be plenty of refreshments and training materials available.
- Concours 101. A classroom presentation, show and tell, and informal discussion of JCNA concours for those unfamiliar with concours but interested in learning about it. No experience is required; you only need an interest in learning more about JCNA concours. One weekend session is planned on May 18th beginning at 1:30 PM in the San Diego Auto Museum training room. The session will last about 90 minutes.

- Concours 201. A session to get Apprentice Judges and Judges whose certification has expired (or is about to) up to speed so that they can participate as Certified Judges at our 2019 Concours. Experience as an Apprentice Judge or former JCNA certified Judge is a "plus", but any member is welcome to participate. Hands on judging of Jaguars using official score sheets, JCNA Concours Rule Books and JCNA Judge's Guides will be emphasized. One weekend session (29/30 June TBD) for Apprentices and anyone else wishing to brush up a bit on concours judging processes. A volunteer will be most welcome to host the event.
- Concours 301. The formal, annual Judges' Refresher Training is required each year by JCNA to recertify
 Judges for the current concours year. It includes a classroom presentation, a review of the more
 important aspects of the JCNA Concours Rule Book, and discussions of the Rule Book changes for
 2019. I plan to highlight the outcome of significant initiatives addressed at the 23 March 2019 AGM and
 their potential impact on our activities. The written 2019 Judges' Test will be administered. Everyone is
 welcome to attend. This is an excellent way for Judges and Entrants to learn more about JCNA Concours
 Rules. Two weekend sessions are planned: Session 1 on Saturday May 18th at the San Diego Auto
 Museum beginning at 9 AM, and session 2 on Saturday June 22nd beginning at 9 AM at Classic
 Showcase in Oceanside. Each session normally lasts about 3 hours.


