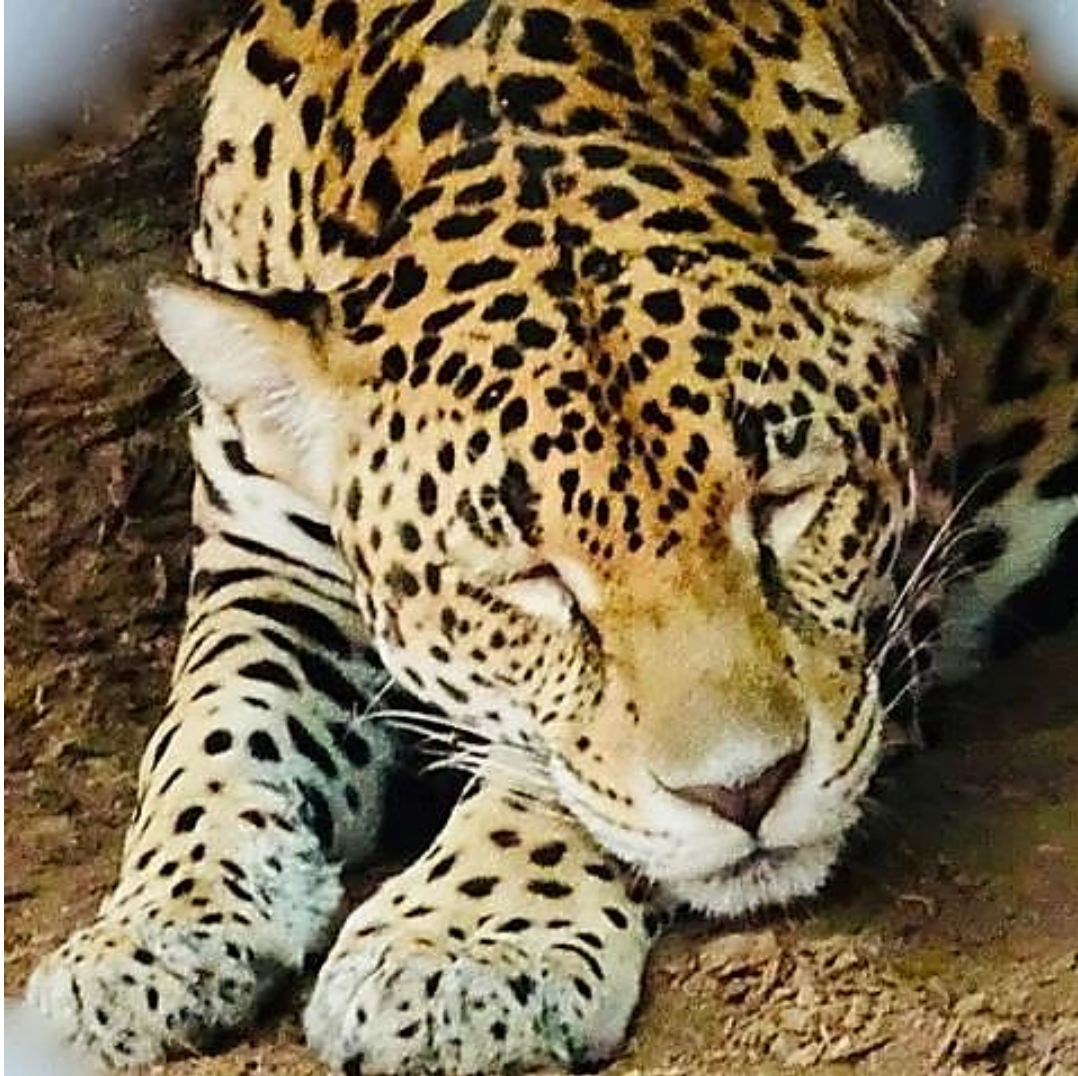

Until then, take care.

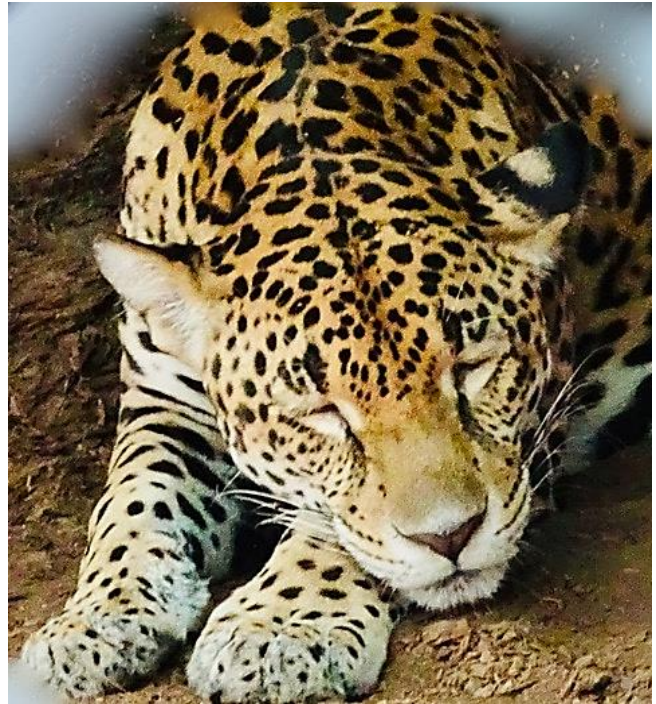

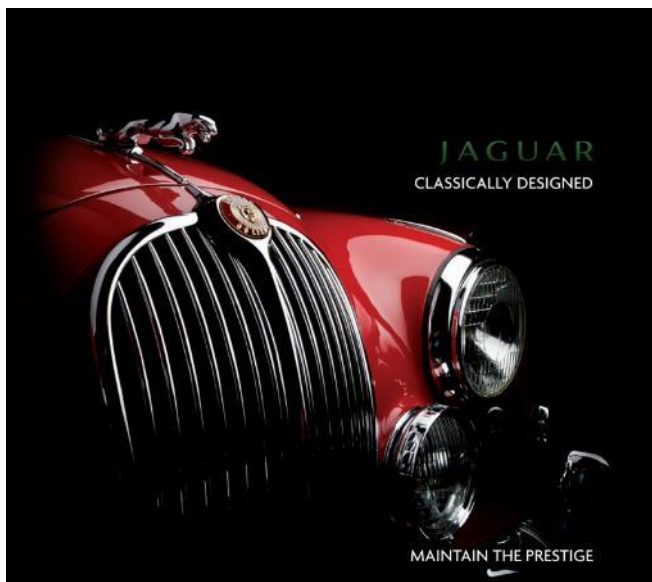

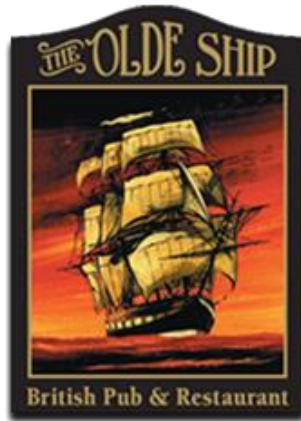

There is only one remaining Concours 301 Refresher Training session slated this year. Training convenes on Saturday June 22nd beginning at 9 AM at Classic Showcase. Congratulations to the four Judges who passed their annual refresher tests on May 18th: Steve Hawley, Jim Singmaster, Al Steele and (Newest Apprentice Judge) Rudy Hradecky.

Blue By You

I just purchased a 2013 XK. I wasn't looking for a 2013 XK. I was actually looking for an F-Type to replace the XE when its lease expires in August. But one day whilst driving through Olympia on I-5 northbound, a most beautiful car caught my eye in my rearview mirror. I slowed to see what it was. What passed me was a black XKR coupe that literally took my breath away.

So, I got to thinking, which is never a good thing; I had owned a progression of XK150, E-Type, XJ-S, then XK8.... you'd think the natural extrapolation would have led me to an XK. Which Ferrari is this?

There have been many Ferrari's built over the decades since the first named Ferrari hit the roads in 1947, the brainchild of Enzo Ferrari.

Those of you with a depth of experience and car enthusiasm can frequently distinguish between a Ferrari's unique sound from that of other super-high-end muscle cars. But, can you distinguish between those subtle variations between a, say, Testarossa, or Spider, or Portofino or the newer GT4 Lu550? That requires vast experience and familiarity with the brand. Most can't of course.

So, here's your test. Just click on the Ferrari button to the right. You've got to be quick because the vehicle darts into the camera's eye in a fraction of a second. You'll be amazed at the musicality of the sound emitted from this very unique, motorized, sensation.

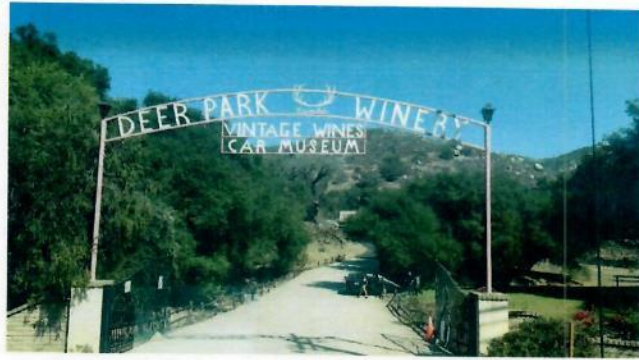

British Car Club Council Representative: Dave – No report.

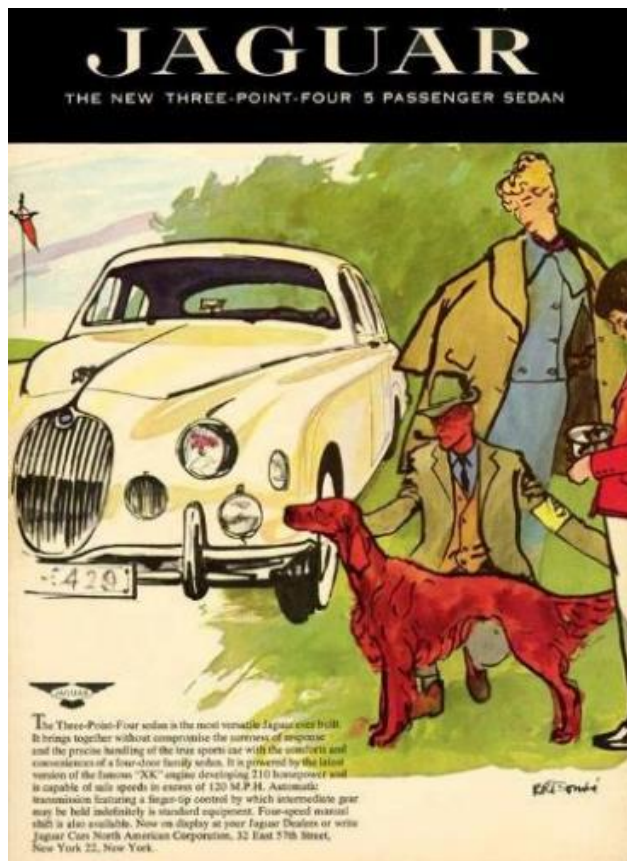
Historian & Roster – No report
