We strive to continue to give you options and implement changes that are not too radical, which is why we have been easing into electronic communication and payments instead of changing too many things at once.

SDJC Holiday Dinner


December 7th, 2019 Recap by Jim Hallameyer Pictures by Matt Allen and Chuck Leuthen

Where in the World

.... were Pete & Christa Rieth?

Pete & Christa are back from parts unknown but Pete, always looking to expand our knowledge, has put together this little quiz. Although the answers are at the bottom of the page, it wouldn't surprise me if these questions show up in one of Pete's concours training sessions. -Ed.


1 - This historical and archaeological city in Jordan is among the mountains north of the Gulf of Aqaba. It is also called the "Rose City" due to the rose color of the stone. The site is believed to have been settled as early as 9,000 BC. It has been a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 1985, and was voted in 2007 as one of the "New 7 Wonders of the World". Can you name the city?


The famous Khazneh structure, shown at the right, is also known as "The Treasury" and can only be accessed through a ¾ mile gorge called the Siq. The final scenes of a **1989 film** take place in the foreground of the Treasury and then they ride their horses through the Siq. The site was largely abandoned and remained unknown to the world until it was rediscovered in 1812 by the Swiss explorer Johann Ludwig Burckhardt. **Can you name the film?**

2 - One of other UNESCO World Heritage sites we visited is the temple of Karnak shown at the right, in **a city in Egypt** along the East bank of the river Nile and was known in ancient times as Thebes. The Hypostyle Hall of Karnak in the Precinct of Amun-Re (shown), has an area of 50,000 ft² with 134 massive columns arranged in 16 rows. Construction of this temple complex started roughly 4500 years ago and lasted until about 30 BCE. Approximately thirty pharaohs contributed to the buildings, enabling it to reach a size, complexity, and diversity not seen elsewhere. Famous scenes in **a 1977 film** take place among these columns. **Can you name the city and the film?**

Notes from the Concours Judges Tent

Soon, our SDJC Concours Judges' cadre will begin its process to spin-up for the 2020 season. I am pleased report that all of our active Judges are currently certified as of 2019 year-end. Well done! Training in the Spring will update certification for all of us. This year's AGM convenes March 19-22 in Las Vegas. The JCNA Concours Rules Committee, of which I am a member, has been hard at work to restructure the process of Judge certification. The AGM delegates will be asked to adopt these proposed changes in an effort to overcome significant weaknesses in the current system. At this writing, while we always have room for improvement, I remain delighted to say that the SDJC Concours Judge Cadre continues to be "at the head of the pack" in terms of the quality of our training and certification program. Thus, the proposed changes will have minimal impact on the way we do business. The most significant proposed change is that Judges will be required to pass the Rules Test annually vice every three years to maintain certification. Decisions taken by the Delegates at the AGM affecting our concours judging procedures and rules will be reflected in updates to the Official JCNA Concours d'Elegance Rule Book and to our standard training materials which derive from it. More to follow.

Mark your calendars for Refresher Training:

Refresher Training for SDJC's JCNA Certified Concours Judges, Apprentices, and Owner/Competitors is scheduled as follows:

May 16th will be at the San Diego Auto Museum – Concours 301 (Judge Refresher Training) session one at 9 AM, and Concours 101 (Concours Information for Participant Owners) beginning at 1 PM - in the upstairs training room.

June 13th will be hosted at Classic Showcase for Concours 301 session two beginning at 9 AM.

Concours 201 (Hands-On practice Judging for Apprentices and optional for Certified Judges) will be scheduled prior to our July 11th concours depending on need and interest level.




Fortunately, I still had the sense to know I was over the limit. That's when I decided to do what I have never done before: I took a cab home.


