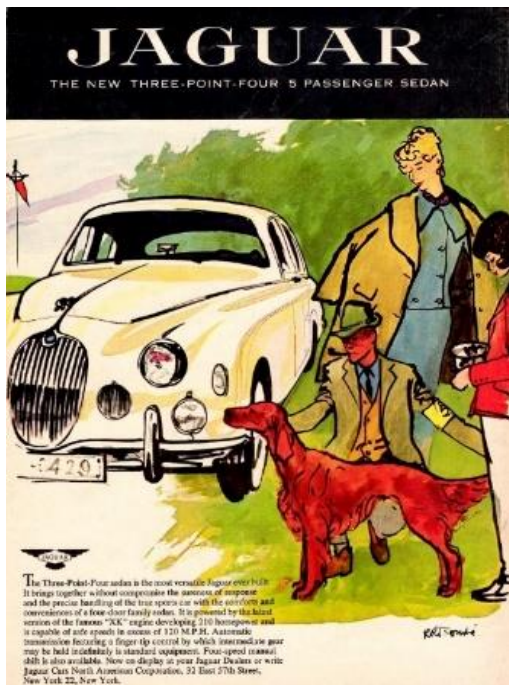

Now you try putting these limericks together with adequate elocution!*

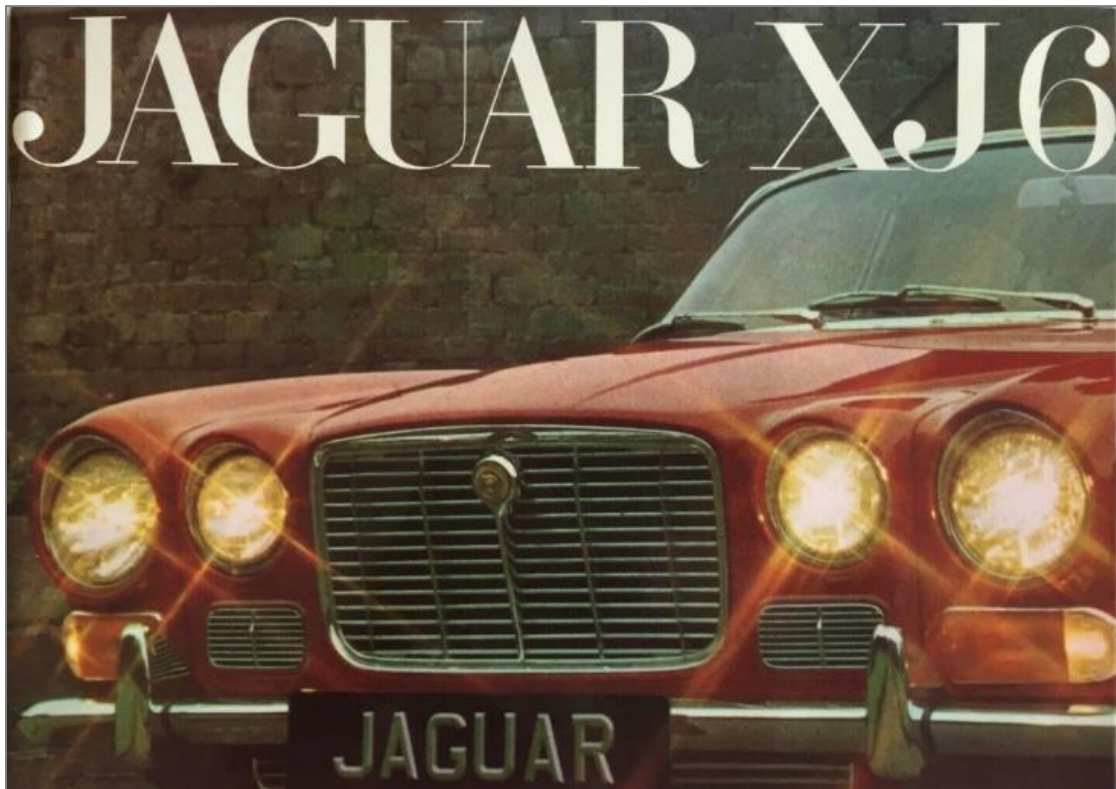

Where in the World...

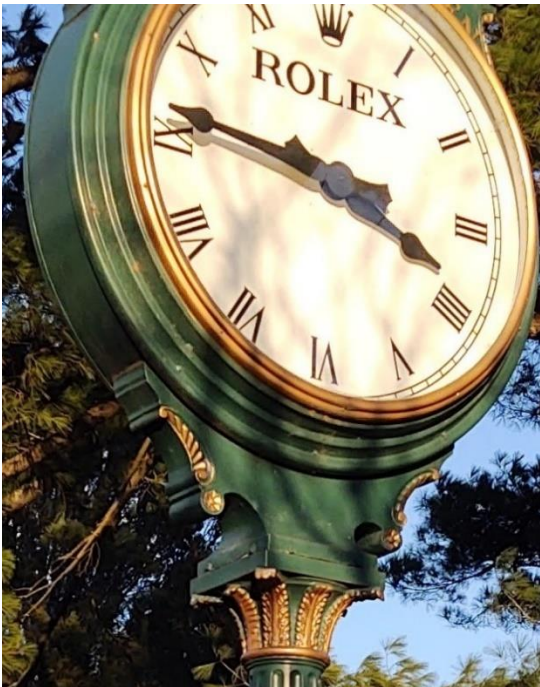
... were the Zverina's?

How better to explain the National and Regional Award process than including a short extract from the JCNA Rule Book (Section 1B):

1. North American Awards

At the conclusion of each JCNA Concours year, JCNA presents the North American Concours d'Elegance Awards three-deep, in each of the Champion, Special, and Driven Division Classes, to members of JCNA affiliates or JCNA Members-at-Large. These annual awards are determined by averaging the Entry's three (3) highest scores during the Concours year. Scores achieved at the JCNA International Jaguar Festival (IJF) qualify for inclusion in the three (3) score average. Entries competed in three or more JCNA Concours automatically become eligible for a North American award in their particular Division and Class. If an Entry's three (3) highest score average does not position it among the top three places of its class, then the Entrant's two (2) highest scores must be evaluated for a Regional Award as per Section 2. No Entrant may receive both a North American and a Regional Award in any given year, in the same Class, for the same Entry.

2. Regional Awards

Regional Awards are presented in each of the six JCNA Regions. These annual awards are determined by averaging the Entrant's two (2) highest scores achieved at JCNA sanctioned Concours within the Entrant's home region during the Concours year. Scores achieved at the JCNA International Jaguar Festival qualify for inclusion in the two (2) score average.

Request for New Judges!

Of course, with so many Concours d'Elegance events we will need as many trained judges as possible. We are definitely looking for a few good women and men to become new Concours Judges. The process to become a judge is simple and training is given. Also, a short period as an apprentice judge is required to gain experience and confidence. Additionally, model preferences are requested to maximize judges' familiarity with specific models.

SDJC Board of Directors Meeting Minutes

January 12, 2022

The meeting was called to order at 6:32 pm via Zoom video conference by Dan Jensen, President. Officers present: Dave Allen, Mark Hodges, Chuck Leuthen, Ann Howe and Nedra Rummell. Directors present: Tim Bennett, and Al Steele. Functional Chairs present: Jim Hallameyer.

Secretary's Report: The minutes of the November 10, 2021 meeting were approved via e-mail.

Treasurer's Report: Dave reported that income for December was \$195.00 comprising \$45.00 received for the Afterglow and \$150.00 for the Holiday party. Expenses for December were \$6,397.77 comprising bank fees (\$170.04), payment to the yacht club for the Holiday Party (\$6,073.74), online filing fee for the SI-100 form (\$5.00), monthly storage facility fees (\$132.00), payment for the web site and Zoom (\$16.99). Overall, net expenses were \$6,202.77 for the month. The large net expense in December was due to the time phasing of payments for the Holiday Party. The ending account balance as of December 31, 2021 was \$38,725.87. Our accounts continue to remain healthy.

First Vice President Activities Report: Nedra (for Diah) reviewed prior and upcoming events, and provided a list of 2022 events:

December 4, 2021 SDJC Holiday Party, Silver Gate Yacht Club, hosted by Celia Hunter: All went well. Food and entertainment were appreciated by all. Nedra pointed out that SDJC subsidized the cost for each attendee in the amount of \$28.00. This was due to the available funds in the club account and the desire of the Board of Directors (BOD) to "give back" to attending SDJC members.

January 8, 2022 - Meet and Drive, Destination Windmill Food Hall, Carlsbad, hosted by Nedra Rummell: The event was well attended with over 25 cars and 36 participants. The route was very popular and will be posted to the SDJC website.

Newsletter Editor Report: Chuck reported that input is on track for the February issue. He is going to advertise for a new editor as he has been doing this for close to 5 years. He suggested BOD members scout for new advertisers for the Tracks.

Website Report: Mark reported that he has deleted the March Borrego Springs event from the website, changed the date of the membership luncheon to Saturday, May 21, archived non-renewing members, deleted expired classified ads, and did basic clean-up of the site. He will send Chuck a note for the Tracks regarding access to the by-laws on the site. Nedra and Mark are working to modify some areas of potential confusion within the website.

Director Reports: No reports

Functional Chair Reports:

Advertising: Dan reported income to date of \$1080 from three advertisers, with an additional \$1080 due from three other advertisers soon.

Auto Museum Representative: Pete Picksley reported that parking has gotten very tight, especially on the three days a week that Comic-con is open. Overflow is going down to the east behind Comic-con and the gym. The museum has a Members-Only Early Admission Day on one Sunday of each month when members can come to the museum before the general public and, as an added bonus, can secure a parking spot in the park before heading out for the day. The next Early Admission Day is Sunday, January 23rd at 9:00 a.m. The museum also hosts Cars and Coffee on the third Sunday of the month in the museum’s parking lot behind the museum between 7:30 a.m. and 9:30 a.m. He thinks the coffee is free and entry may be granted through the back door close to the parking area. The museum is also working on initiating an automotive education program for teenagers – more info to follow.

British Car Club Council Representative: No report.

Concours: Mark has been doing research on solar-powered generators that could be used at the concours instead of paying for a DJ and sound system at \$700 for the day. Preliminary research determined that the cost of a solar generator would be \$700-\$800, thereby paying for itself in one year. He will do more checking and provide more information at the next BOD meeting.

Property Manager: Nothing to report.

Chief Judge: Dave A. reported that he is looking for new judges. There will be a virtual training event on March 2 and a hands-on practice for new judges. He is looking for a venue for this.

Dealer Rep: Jim continues to attempt to set up a tour of San Diego Jaguar. He will stop by to meet with David Drake, General Manager, and Michael Hames, Sales Manager.

Raffles: Nedra reported she has found lots of new raffle items for upcoming events. From the proceeds of raffle sales, she spent \$430 on candy, floral arrangements, and chair bows for the Holiday Party. She will send the checks and expense report to Dave.

Roster – The JCNA renewal deadline is approaching. Nedra updated the JCNA roster and will be sending it to Cara Dillion by the end of the week. Renewal checks are being mailed to Dave A. tomorrow. The income report will reflect the checks received today.

Awards - Nedra requested the Tuescher trophy/plates from Mark for the end of the year engraving.

Old Business

- **Use of social media** – Nedra reported that due to issues regarding the inability to log-on to the site, building our presence on social media has been delayed. However, it is a priority for 2022. JCNA is encouraging all clubs to become more active on Social Media.
- **Bylaws change** – Dan reported that the changes to the bylaws were made last November and should be voted on towards the end of this year by the membership. In the meantime, they should be reviewed to ensure accuracy and continued relevance. The only change of note will be deletion of the Logo Wear Functional Chair given that SDJC items are now purchased on line from Land's End.
- **Meeting with Jaguar San Diego** – See Dealer Rep report above.

New Business:

- **Articles in Tracks Regarding Member Access to Bylaws, etc.** – There was discussion regarding the possibility of making the website more user friendly. Some BOD members had difficulty locating certain items, e.g., the club bylaws.
- **Coventry Foundation Donation** – The original sponsorship was \$250.00. The annual renewal is reduced to \$100.00 thereafter. Nedra made a motion to renew SDJC's sponsorship. It was seconded by Dave. The vote passed unanimously.
- **SDJC COVID Policy (new item)** – Al asked what the club's policy was regarding COVID and suggested that members be asked if they are vaccinated when registering for an event. Dan stated that the BOD adheres to the policies of the host facilities, citing the recent Holiday Party at the Silver Gate Yacht Club as an example where masks were required for those who were unvaccinated. Dave pointed out that the club has also taken steps to lessen COVID-related concerns, e.g., hosting most 2021 events outdoors. Following discussion by other BOD members and functional chairs, Dan suggested the topic be tabled until next month, during which time the meeting attendees can further reflect on the topic.
